

# Taking simple precautions can prevent heater fires

Now that the cold weather is here, you can help prevent heating fires by taking a few simple precautions. Your local fire department suggests the following:

- Space heaters need space. They are

- not to be used as a drying rack.

- Keep anything that can burn at least one metre (three feet) away from your space heater.
- Teach children NEVER to play near the heater and always to keep toys and

- clothes away from it.

- Plug space heaters directly into a wall socket, do not use extension cords. Always unplug your heater when not in use.
- When purchasing a new space heater,

- make sure that it meets the ULC/CSA approval.

- Ensure the heater has an automatic shut-off switch if it is tipped over.
- Be sure to always follow

the manufacturer's instructions for installation and placement.

Considering these simple safety steps can help prevent fires.
