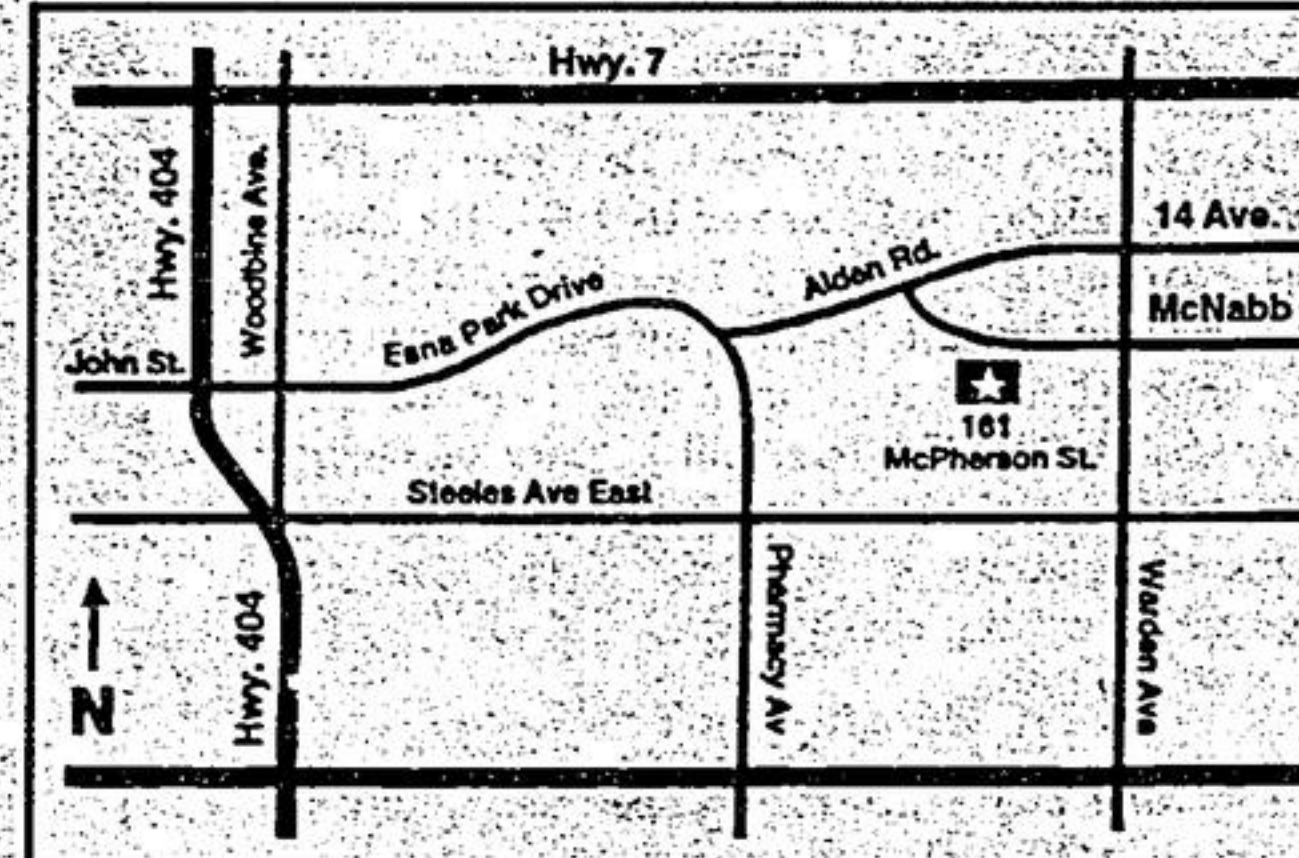

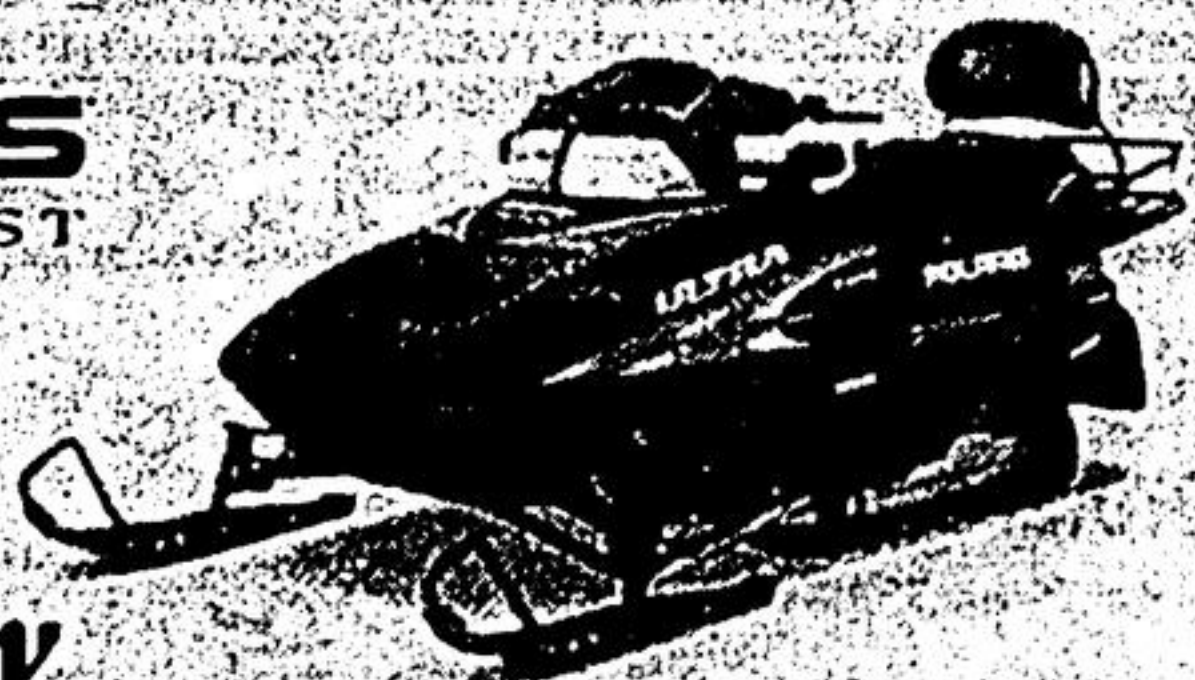
Ya but: I don't know the first thing about driving a snowmobile!!

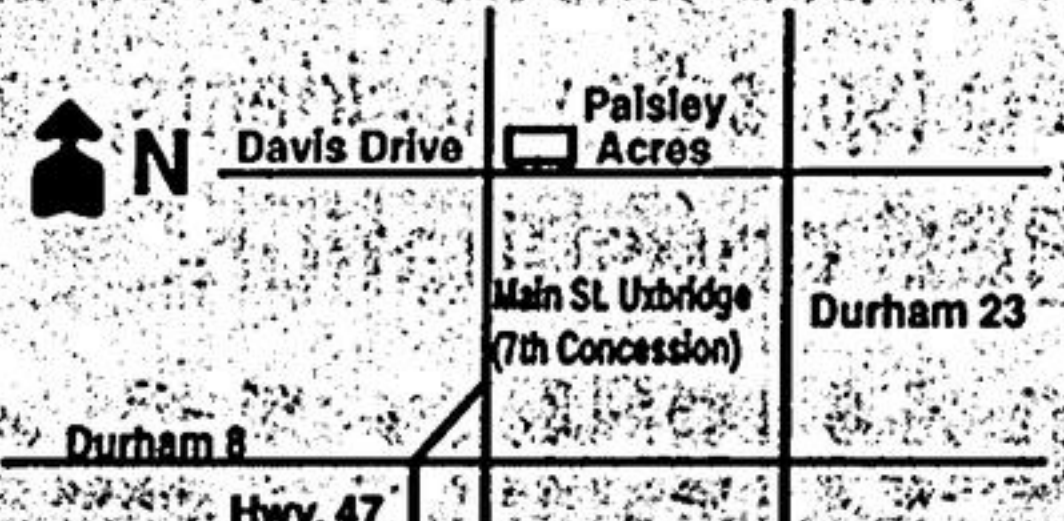
