

Bethlehem Live '97 starts Thursday at Christian Blind Mission

Some 50 Markham and Stouffville district churches are sharing in one way or another for the presentation over the next two weekends of Bethlehem Live! '97. This special Christmas feature, now in its fifth season, has become a popular local tradition.

Many of the churches will have members in the cast. More than 140 people in period costume, includ-

ing 12 babies and their parents, are required for the re-enactment of the Christmas story.

Others will or have served behind the scenes in costume and prop preparation, publicity, parking, crowd control, the serving of refreshments, etc., etc. Those looking after parking are ably assisted by members of the Stouffville Lions Club.

Bethlehem Live! '97 is an outdoor re-enactment of the trip to

Bethlehem that Mary and Joseph would have taken almost 2,000 years ago, encountering the kinds of people along the way that they also might have met. Persons attending will be grouped into "families" of 15 for their trip to Bethlehem. Interaction with soldiers, prophets, shepherds and wise men will occur along the route.

Every attempt is made to take participants out of the 20th Century to get the feel of the time. Even the lighting is all by natural flame.

Since the evening walk is outdoors, those

attending are urged to dress warmly. The presentation runs from 6 to 9 p.m. nightly, Thursday through Sunday, Nov. 20 to 23 and 27 to 30.

Staging is on the back lot of Christian Blind Mission International. Parking is at the Springvale Baptist Church, 3701 Stouffville Rd., just east of Kennedy Road, from which people are shuttle-bused to the site.

Approximately 1,000 people are expected each night with busloads from across southern Ontario. A donation of \$2 per person or \$5 for families is requested.
