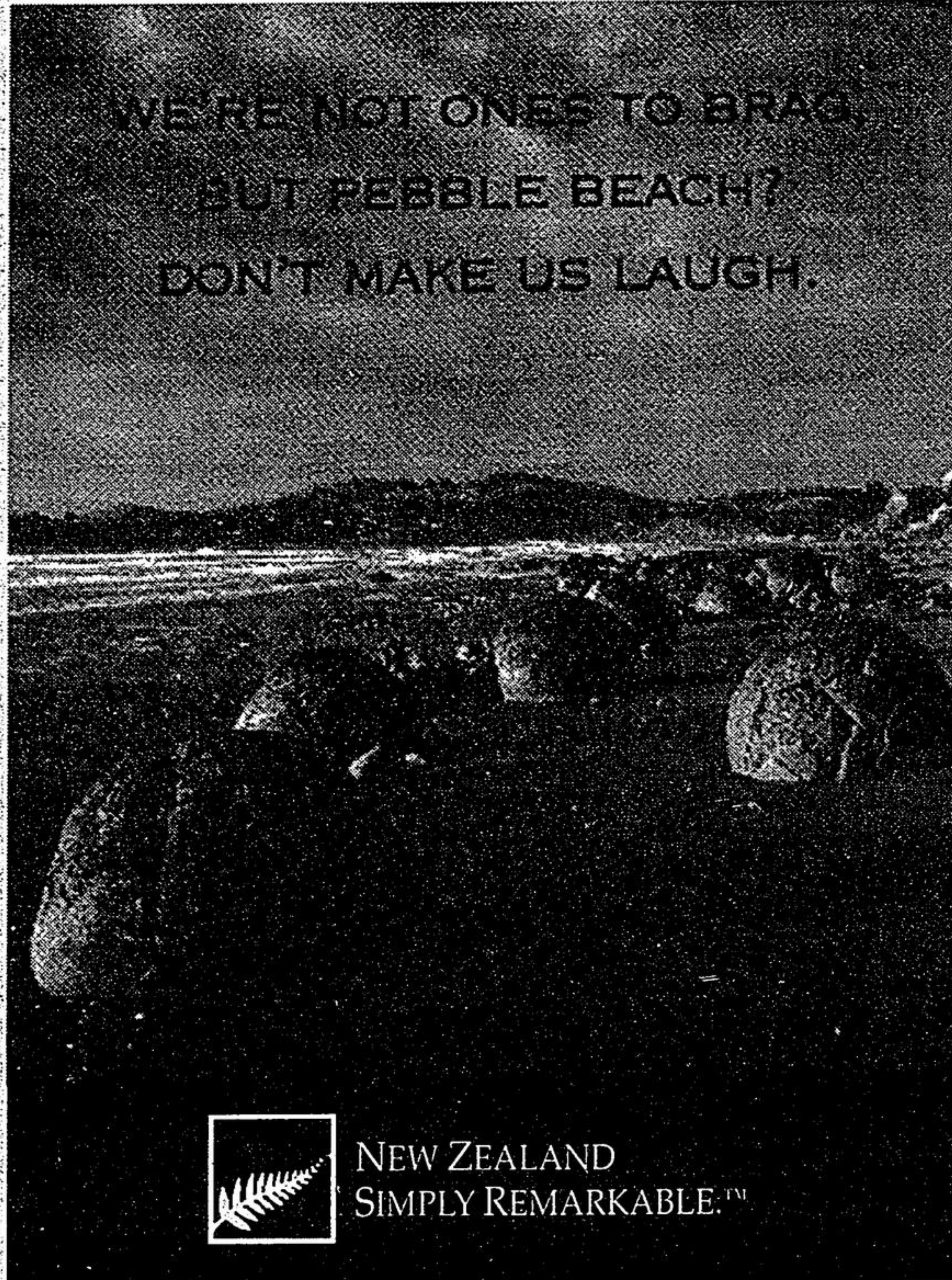
adventure forth or simply let go and relax, you will be doing it in one of nature's masterpieces.
