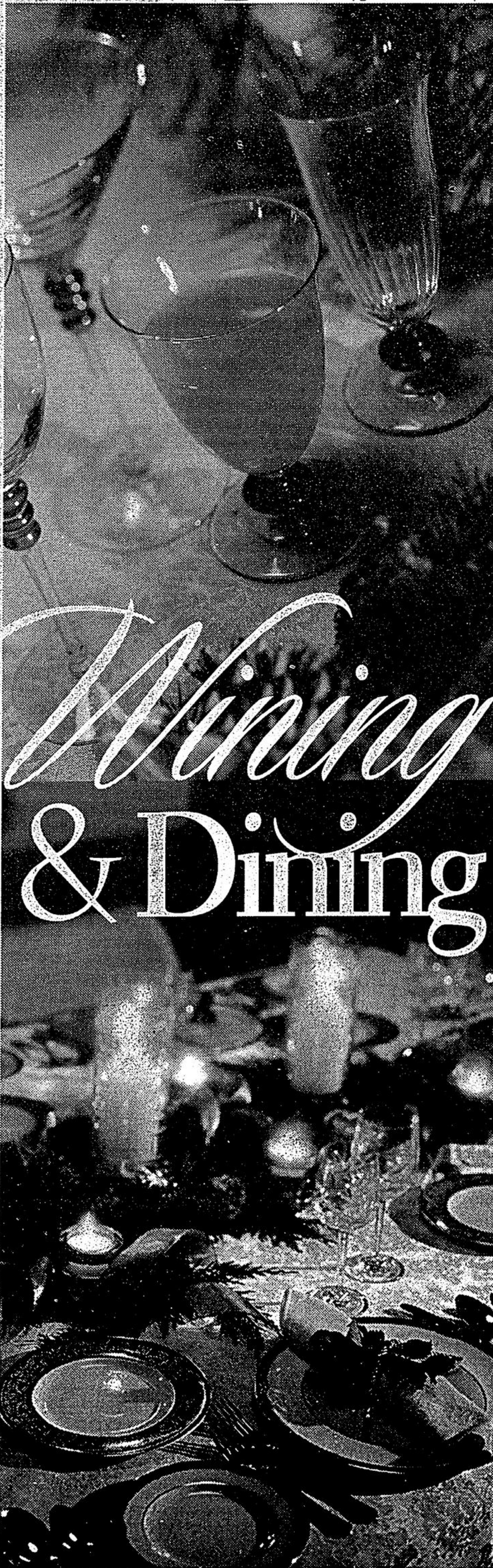
been phenomenal, said organizer Ruth LeBlanc.
