Perform a seven-point inspection of vehicle prior to extreme cold weather *Inspection should include looking at cooling and ignition system, battery and tires, including the spare*

Extreme weather conditions can spell disaster for the unprepared motorist. That's why it is important to weatherproof the vehicles now. Winter weather can put a tremendous strain on vehicles that haven't been properly maintained. In fact, many automotive shop owners such as Dave Doll,

who is also president of the National Automotive Radiator Service Association, said winter is one of their busiest times of the year.

"Many people wait until there is a problem to bring their vehicle into a shop and it seems that problems usually surface during extreme weather conditions," said Doll.

"But preventive maintenance can help motorists

avoid problems, emergency repairs and replacements, effectively saving them time, trouble and money and the dangerous possibility of being stranded."

One of the most important parts of a vehicle is the cooling system, which is designed to protect the engine from the destructive effects of too much heat.

Experts recommend the following seven-point check designed to identify any areas that need attention: It consists of:

1. a radiator pressure cap test to check for the recommended system pressure level;
2. a thermostat check for proper opening and closing;
3. a pressure test to identify any external leaks to cooling system parts,

including the radiator, water pump, engine coolant passages, radiator and heater hoses and heater core;

4. an internal leak test to check for combustion gas leakage into the cooling system;

5. a visual inspection of all cooling system components, including belts and hoses;

6. a system power flush and refill with the car manufacturer's recommended concentration of coolant;

7. an engine fan test for proper operation.

In addition to a complete cooling system inspection motorists should have the following components checked before winter arrives:

- battery;
- brakes;

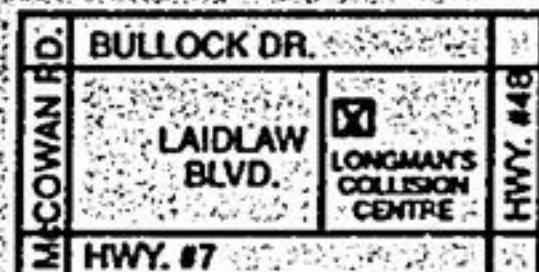

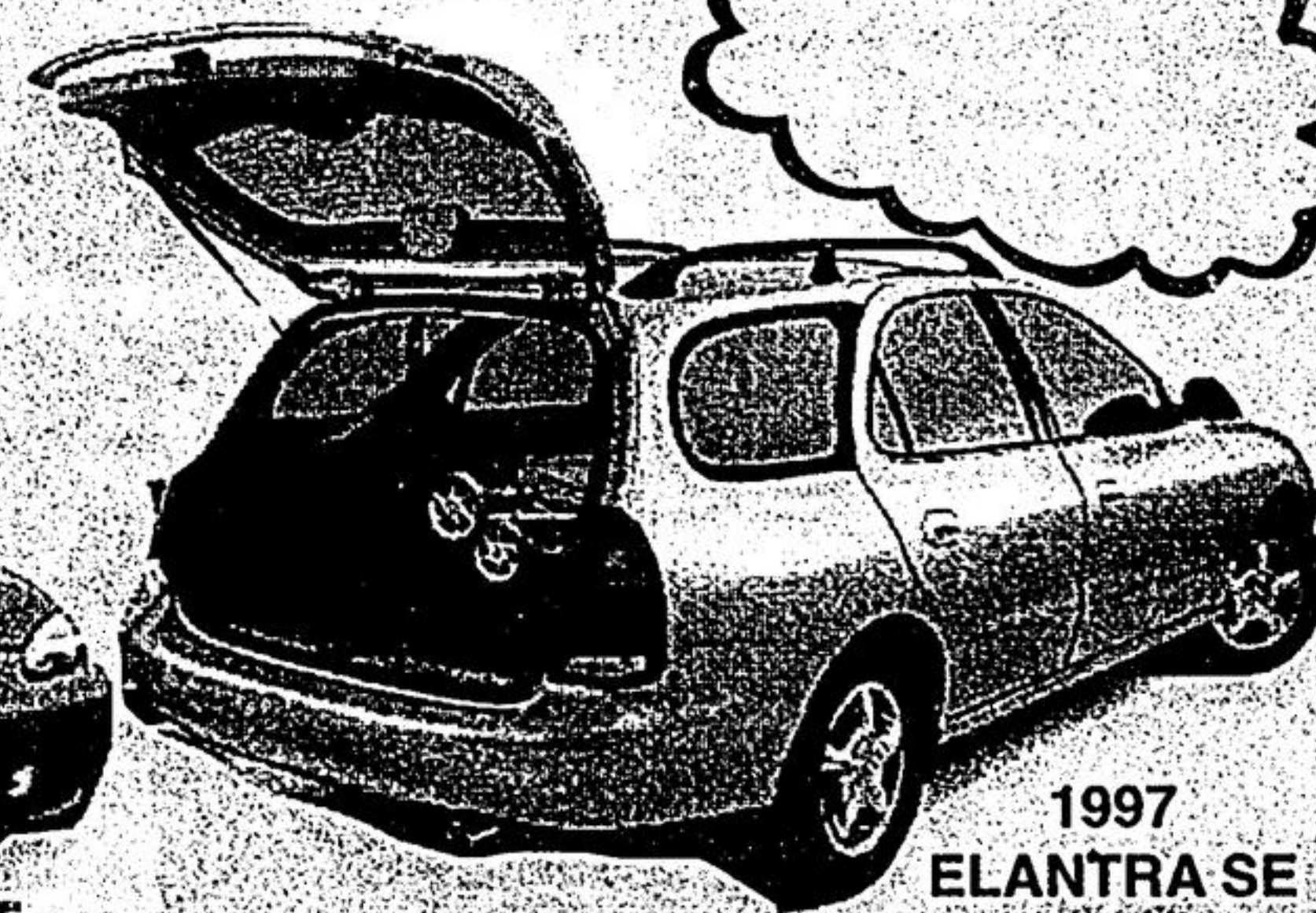

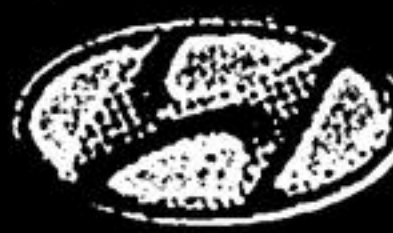
