New works by accomplished local artist Lillian Richardson will be on display this weekend at Chalet Studio, 2195 Uxbridge South Town Line in Claremont.

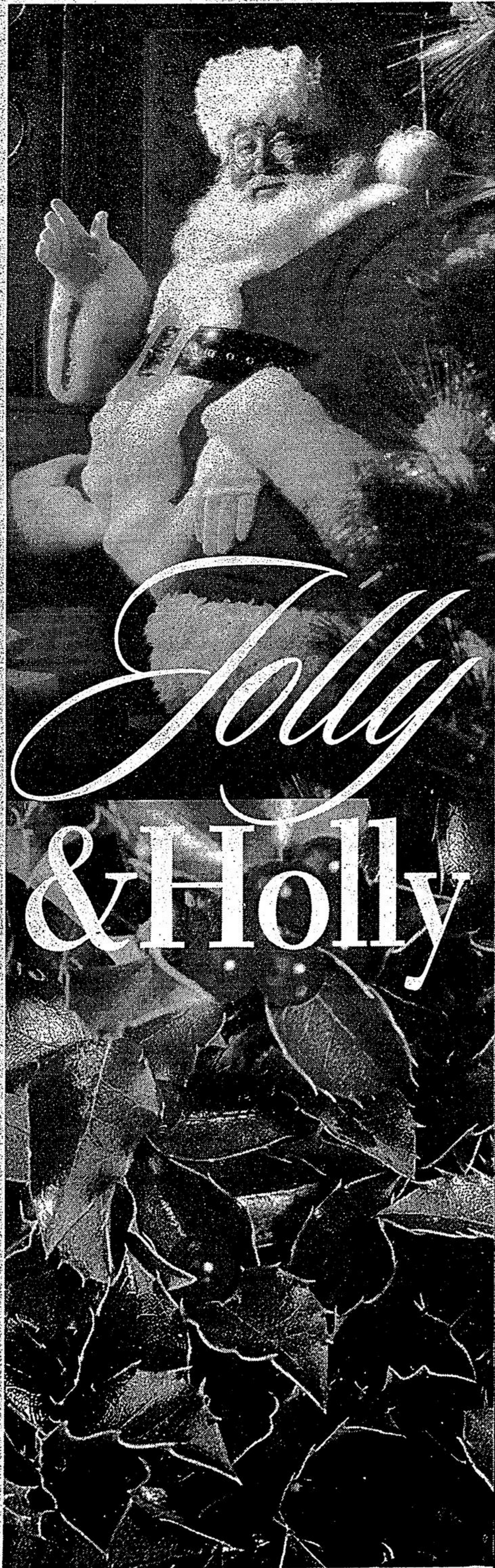
