## PUBLIC NOTICE NOTICE TO SNOWMOBILERS

Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville By-Law No. 93-22 provides that motorized snow vehicles SHALL NOT BE OPERATED at the following locations and times within the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville:

- On any sidewalk, public park or cemetery
- On any private property without the owner's or occupant's consent
- On any part of Main Street between Sandale Road and the 10th Concession nor on the travelled portion of:
  1. Main Street west of Sandale Road
  2. Main Street east of the 10th Concession of Durham Road 30
  3. 10th Concession north of Main Street to Hemlock Drive
- In any built-up area (per Schedule "A" to By-Law No. 93-22)
  - Between 1:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. on Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays
  - Between 11:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. on any other day

### NOTE: REGARDING SPEED

In accordance with the Motorized Snow Vehicle Act, Section 13, no person shall drive a motorized snow vehicle at a greater speed than,

- 20 kilometres per hour on a highway where the speed limit is 50 kilometres per hour or less, or
- 50 kilometres per hour on a highway where the speed limit is greater than 50 kilometres per hour.

## Hospital receives \$100G grant

The Markham-Stouffville Hospital will receive \$100,000 from the province to combat diabetes.

MPP Dave Tsubouchi made the announcement yesterday, saying the money will be used

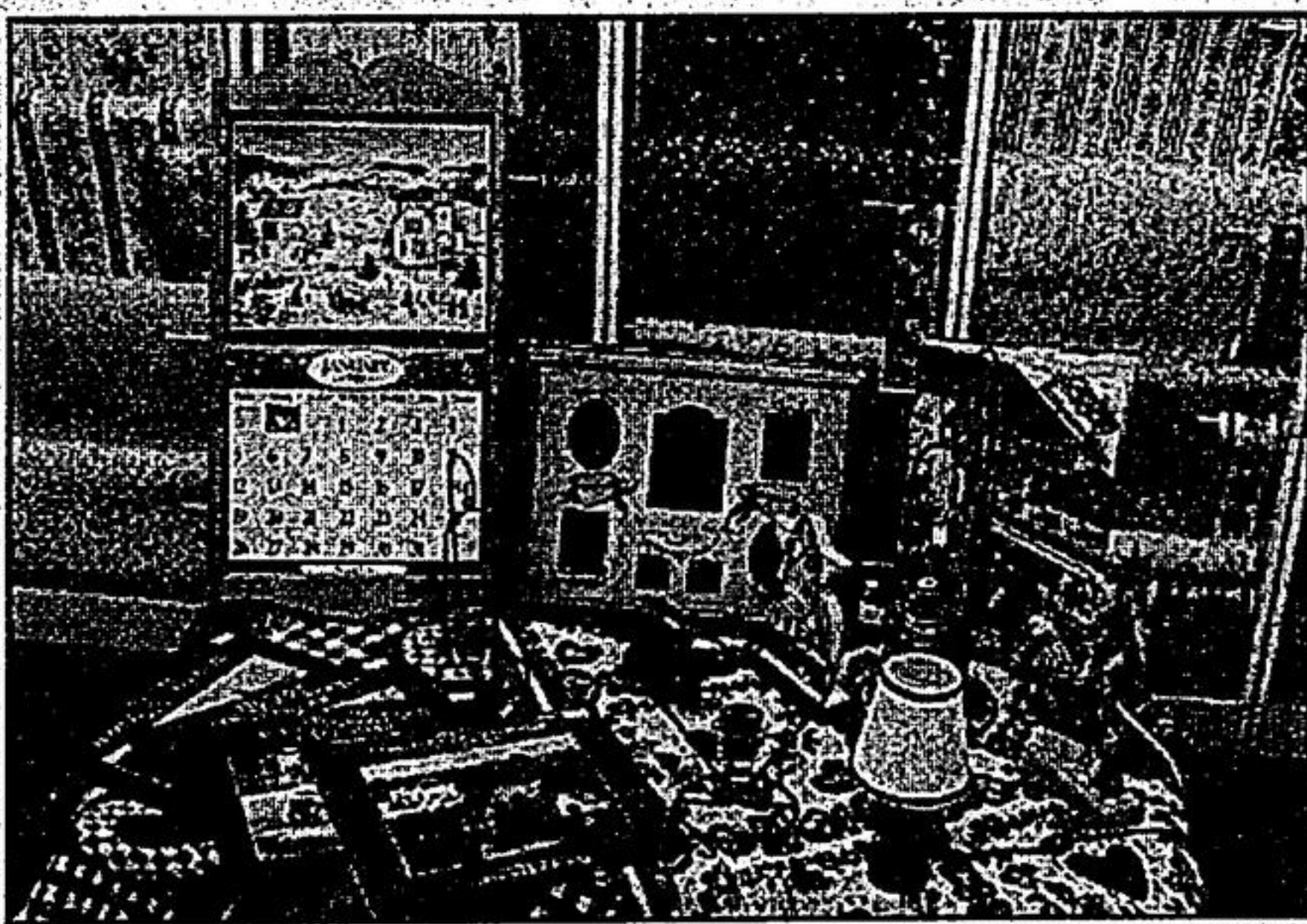
for public education to help promote diabetes prevention.

The money comes from a three-year \$5.8 million provincial commitment to improve education, counselling and assessment services to diabetics

and their families. Diabetes is responsible for an estimated 50 per cent of all heart attacks, 70 per cent of strokes, 50 per cent of non-traumatic amputation and 55 per cent of new cases of blindness.
