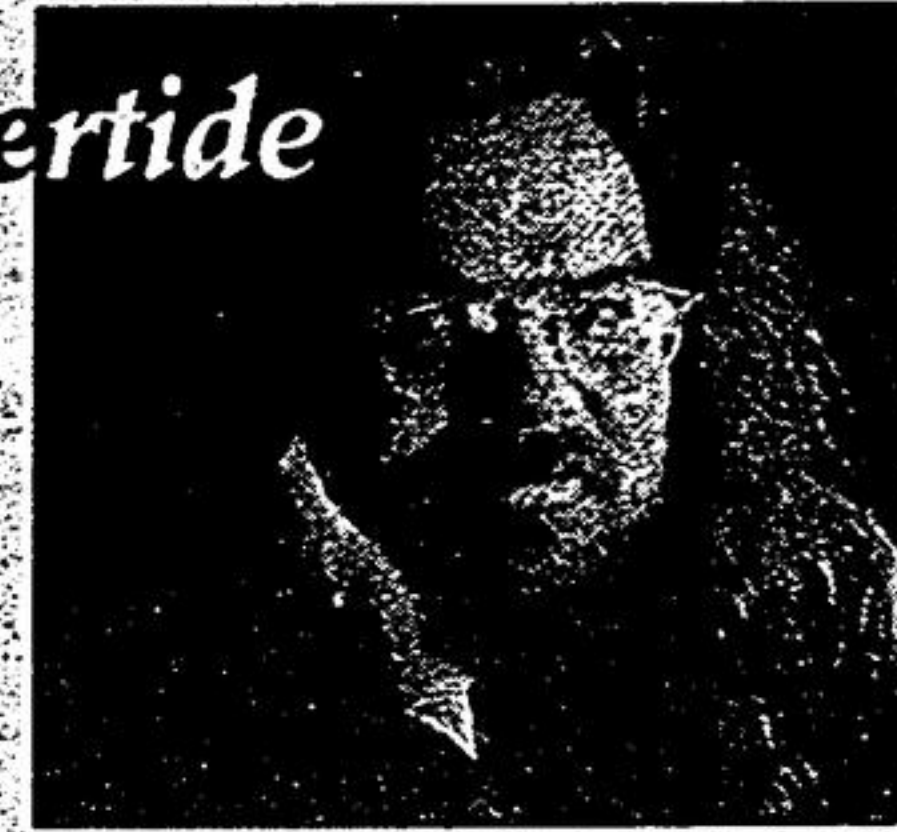

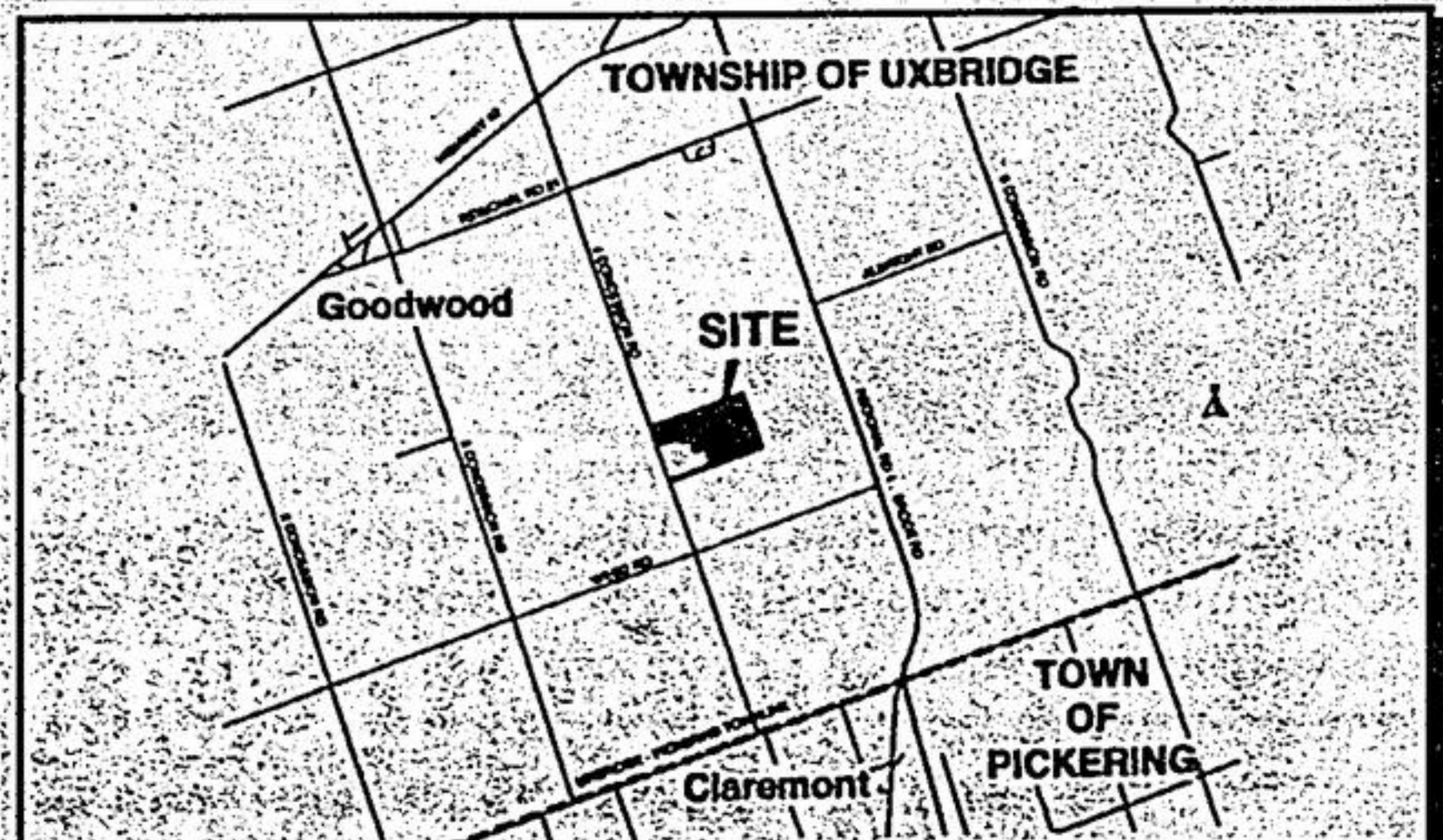


## THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF DURHAM NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

### PURPOSE OF THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT REGIONAL FILE NO.: OPA 97-024

The Regional Municipality of Durham is considering an application to amend the Durham Regional Official Plan to permit a 44 lot country residential subdivision on private services in the location shown on the sketch below.

If you wish to make a written submission or if you wish to be notified of subsequent meetings or the adoption of the proposed Amendment, please write to the Commissioner of Planning, Box 623, Whitby, Ontario, L1N 6A5. ### APPEAL

If a person or public body that files a notice of appeal of a decision for the proposed official plan amendment to the Ontario Municipal Board does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or does not make written submissions before the proposed official plan amendment is adopted, the Ontario Municipal Board may dismiss all or part of the appeal.
