Changes coming to local hospice

The new year of 1998 will bring a number of changes to Hospice Markham-Stouffville.

Within the first few weeks of the year, our name will officially be changed to Evergreen Hospice of Markham-Stouffville.

The offices will remain at 6060 Hwy. 7 in Markham and the provision of services will continue to focus on providing supportive care to individuals and families dealing with a life-threatening illness.

Day Program

During the month of January, two new programs will be inaugurated. The first, to begin on Jan. 14 is a Day Program which will be held each Wednesday.

This program will provide support to individuals and their families in a home like setting, away from their own homes.

A variety of activities are planned and may include such things as massage, relaxation and medita-

tion, arts and crafts, music, humour, outings and celebrations. Professional staff and trained volunteers will be managing the program to be housed at St. Andrew's United Church.

The Day Program is open to persons in Markham and Whitchurch-Stouffville who are living with a life threatening illness.

Clients must be cognitively aware and able to manage their own medications; over 18 years of age; and able to walk with aid or in a wheelchair.

The program will run from 9:30 a.m. to 2 p.m., with a lunch being provided.

Bridges of Hope, a grief support program, will meet the fourth Sunday of each month at 1:30 p.m., beginning Jan. 28 at the hospice office.

The monthly drop-in format providing support, education and resources will be open to anyone who has been impacted by death.

Professional staff, specially trained volunteers and guest speakers will assist with each session.

New topics

Topics for 1998 include: Four Seasons of Grief; Managing Stress, Practical Issues - Legal; Practical Issues - Financial; Coping with Anger and Guilt; and Establishing New Relationships.

Volunteers needed to aid brain-injured
