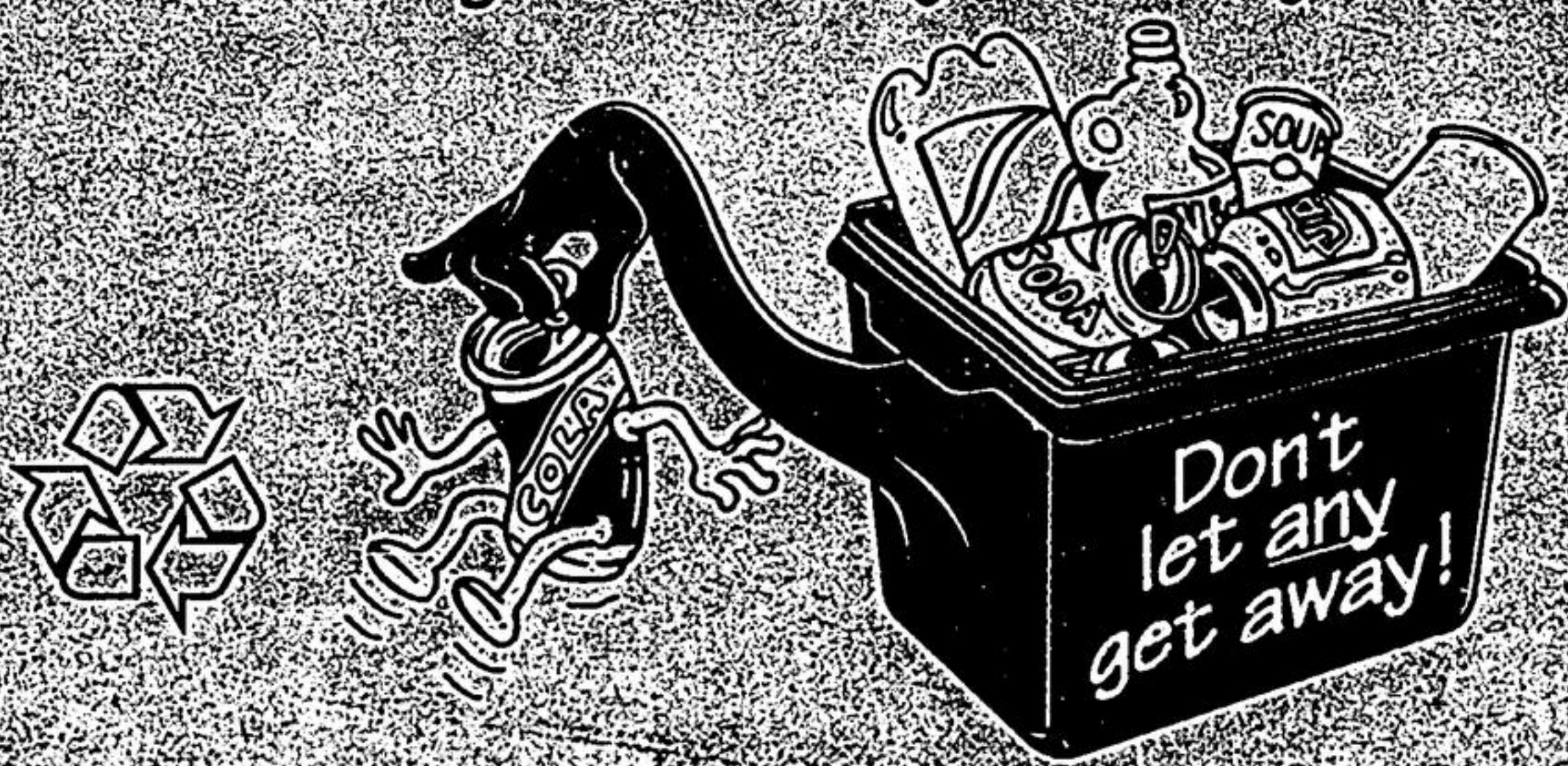
DON'T TRASH CANS!
