

Region names committee chairs

Members of York Regional Council this week selected the chairs and vice-chairs of council's standing committees.

On Wednesday, the Transportation and Works Committee elected Richmond Hill Mayor William F. Bell as chair and Regional Councillor Gord Landon of Markham as vice-chair. Later, Georgina Mayor Robert Grossi was chosen to lead the Economic Development Committee, with Regional Councillor Joyce Frustaglio of Vaughan as vice-chair.

On Thursday, the Finance and Administration Committee elected Markham Mayor Don Cousens as its chair and Newmarket Mayor Tom Taylor to serve as vice-chair. At the afternoon meeting of the Health and Social Services Committee, Regional Councillor Joyce Frustaglio was named chair, with King Mayor Margaret Black acting as vice-chair.

Still to be named are the chair and vice-chair of the Planning Committee, which is scheduled to hold its first meeting on Jan. 21.
