NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE

At its March 13, 1997 meeting, Regional Council adopted a report authorizing the preparation of an Environmental Assessment for the Bloomington Area Water Supply in the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville.

The project is being undertaken in accordance with the requirements of the Class Environmental Assessment for Municipal Water Projects prepared by the Municipal Engineers' Association. A Public Information Centre has been arranged to outline the planning done to date, present alternative solutions being considered, and solicit public comment.

Following the Public Information Centre alternative solutions will be evaluated and a recommended solution will be identified. A Phases 1 and 2 Report will be prepared documenting the planning process. Copies of the Report will be filed with the Regional Transportation and Works Department, the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville Clerk, and the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville Library for public review.
