Hollywood stable to cast the film, Scorsese chose to use real Tibetans. While that gives the film an authentic feel, the actors aren't particularly compelling and fail to bring across the script's inherent emotions. Then there's the pacing. Scorsese plays every scene like a climax complete with throbbing electronic score courtesy of new age composer Philip Glass. Where the film is strongest is in its look. From the magnificent outdoor scenes to the colorful indoor ceremonies, every frame drips with colour and style. It's just too bad it lacks the narrative substance to do the style justice.
