Everyone is invited to visit the Care and Share Shoppe this week to watch or take part in a quilting bee with a difference. Volunteers are making up quilt blankets for people in areas such as Bangladesh, Bosnia, Iran, North Korea, Russia, Serbia, Sudan, Ukraine, Zaire - wherever the need is greatest. Unlike traditional quilts, these are tied and knotted and the method is easy to pick up, said organizer Gerald Reesor. "It's something that even children can do. People can come in and look if they like or they can join the circle. It's a nice way for them to learn about a Mennonite tradition and to get together and make something for somebody else." The quilting bee will continue throughout the week from 10 a.m. until 5:30 p.m. Tuesday to Thursday, 10 a.m. to 9 p.m. Friday and 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday. In 1997, 73,975 blankets were sent out by Mennonite Central Committee in North America.

LOCAL ARTISTS AT GALLERY
 "One Landscape: Six Views" is the title of a new exhibition which opened Sunday at the Latham Gallery, Lorna Fru, Margaret Grandison, Lorne Grove, Ray McNiece, John Roberts and Pamela Wright are the six acclaimed artists who have been working together for the past year in a loose affiliation known as The Roadside Painters Group. Stouffville's group of six was initiated

ed when some of John Roberts' former night school students came up with the idea of painting together on weekends. Last year, gallery director/curator Christopher Jackson suggested a show of their work. "If I remember correctly, at that point it was 'One Landscape: Four Views', but the group seemed to grow a bit over time," he recalled. "I thought this could be very interesting for both the artists and the public. Other than John, who has been an artist and teacher for more than 30 years, the group's members hadn't really been in exhibitions that focused on their work. Having just started at the Latham Gallery, I was looking for ideas for exhibitions that would feature local artists, and the possibilities of this show were intriguing."
