MPP has 'interest conflict' in casino initiative: critics

The companies picked to run two permanent charity casinos in York Region say MPP Dave Tsubouchi has conflicting responsibilities on the issue.

Tsubouchi, as Ontario's minister of consumer and commercial affairs, oversees the regulation of gambling but is also charged with "implementing" the program — that is, with "selling" the idea of a charity casino to municipalities.

And Tsubouchi cannot sell the initiative "with the same degree of urgency" as someone who isn't also in charge of regulating gambling, said Paul Christie, speaking for the seven potential operators of charity casinos in Ontario.

"There is a bit of a conflict of interest," he said this week, adding the companies aren't criticizing Tsubouchi's performance. "It's pretty tough for an individual to cover the sales role as well as the regulatory role," Christie said.

In a speech to a gambling industry audience this month, Tsubouchi acknowledged concerns about "my dual role," saying he feels it "needs clarification." The charity casinos, opposed by Markham Council and by residents in many communities, are behind schedule. Though in September the province announced the companies as "final proponents" for its charity casinos, including two for York Region, contracts are still not signed and background checks are apparently incomplete.

Christie, director of the companies' Gaming Operators' Association, said municipalities will soon give "real consideration" to charity gaming.

"We welcome the scrutiny," he added. In the meantime, a ban on roving "Monte Carlo" charity casinos is set to begin March 31.
