

Local personalities get in line-up for Jail-N-Bail event

The Markham/Whitchurch-Stouffville Unit of the Canadian Cancer Society, with the generous assistance of the Kiwanis Clubs of Markham and Unionville, is holding its third Jail-N-Bail fundraiser on Wednesday, April 1 at Markville Shopping Centre from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

"Jailbirds agree to be charged and tried for a fun and fictitious offenses under the Jail-N-Bail Act," said fundraising chair Liz Lightfoot. "They cover their bail by collecting pledges prior to the event. Then on April 1, they appear before a judge to plead their case, spend time behind bars, and post bail."

Twenty-six jailbirds are confirmed, said Lightfoot. "We ask that the public support our jailbirds by contributing generously."
