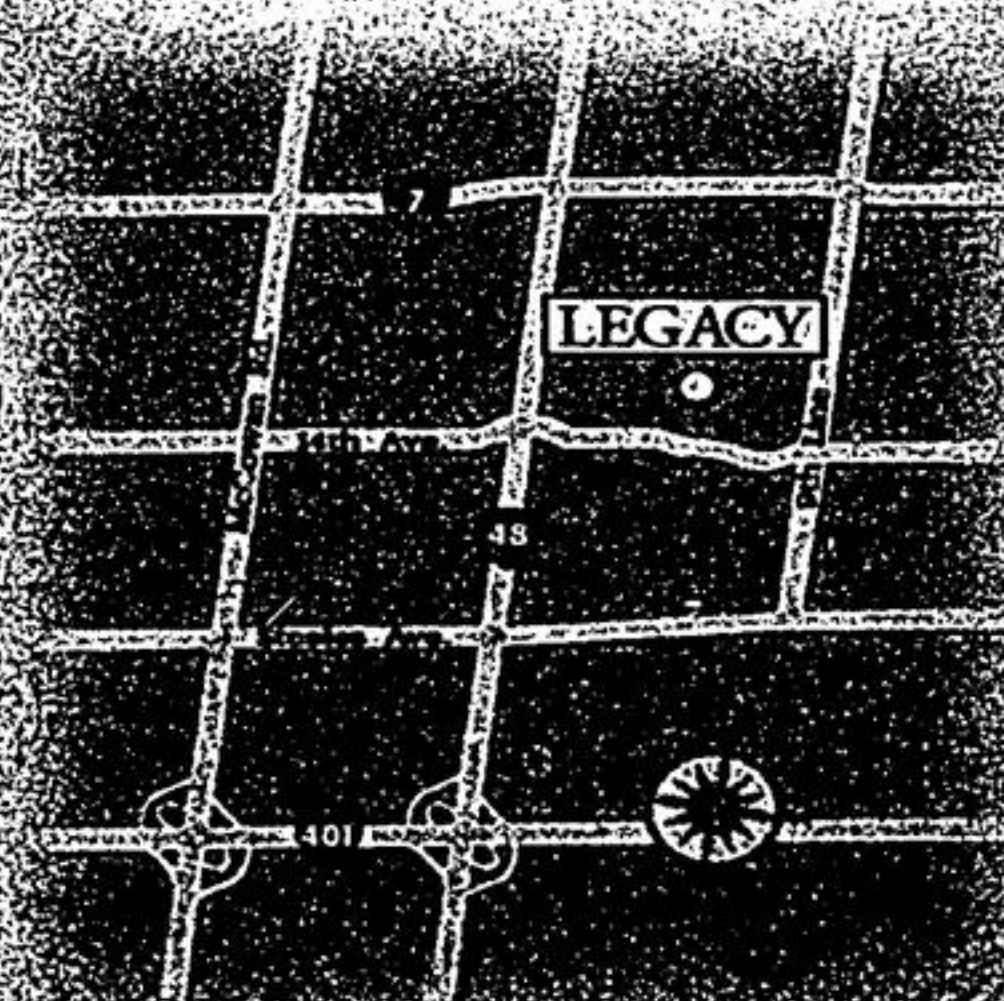
## A MILLIONAIRE BUILT IT. ARNOLD PALMER PLAYED IT. YOU CAN LIVE IT.
