Seat belt campaign wraps up April 14

Transportation Minister Tony Clement is urging parents and caregivers to make sure their children are correctly buckled up in car safety seats.

Nearly two-thirds of children in Ontario are not secured correctly in their child safety seats. That is why police officers and health professionals will focus on reminding parents and caregivers that they must secure their children correctly during the spring provincial seat-belt campaign, which ends April 14.

"The price you pay is a \$105 fine and two demerit points if your child is not buckled up correctly," Clement said. "The price you pay if a child is injured or killed is incalculable."

Ontarians must also do better in using seat belts to secure older children and adults. In the first two decades after Ontario introduced mandatory seat belt legislation in 1976, seat belt use rose from 7.1 to more than 92 per cent in 1996, saving thousands of lives. However, according to Transport Canada's 1997 Seat Belt Survey, the compliance rate for Ontario drivers has slipped by nearly one per cent to 91 per cent. When combined with passengers, the compliance rate slips even further to 89 per cent.

"The law is there to protect you and your children. If you don't abide by it, you could end up being the big loser - you could lose the lives of those you love," says Clement.

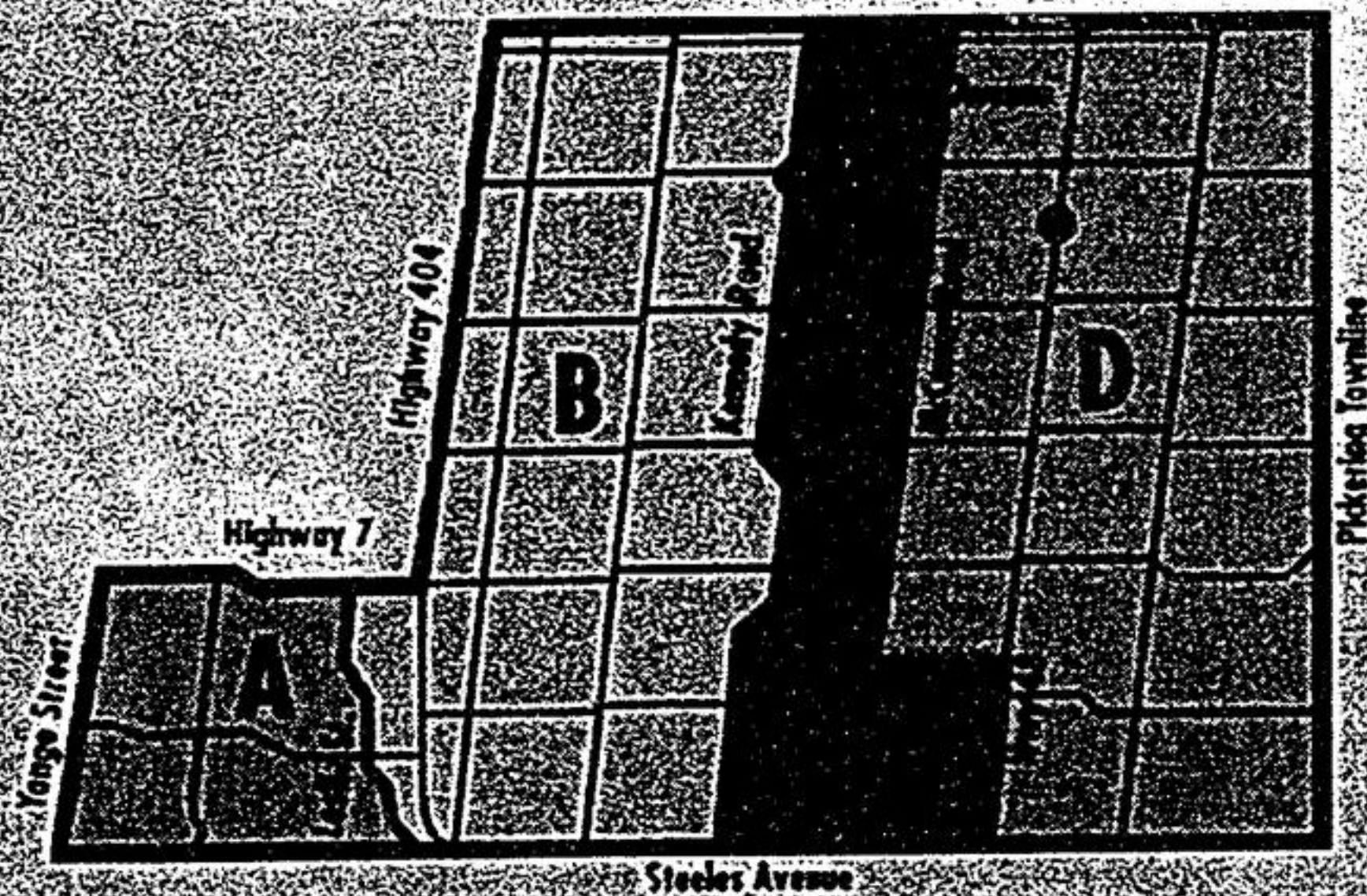
