# Region won't include flea market in big plans

The new Secondary Plan for downtown Stouffville has hit a snag.

The Region of York has recommended that five areas, including the Stouffville Country Market be deferred.

Whitchurch-Stouffville Council is expected to support the region, putting the 10th Line business in limbo and giving the appropriate

parties a chance to come to an agreement on various issues.

The Secondary Plan is the framework to be used as a guide when local government decides planning matters, including what goes where in the area known as Old Stouffville.

The town has hired consultant Elizabeth Howson to outline how it might manage itself as the pop-

ulation of Whitchurch-Stouffville is projected to grow to nearly 40,000 by the Year 2021.

The final document, valued at \$300,000, took nine months to prepare. Once local council gives the nod to exclude the Country Market from the big picture, York council can pass the vital document.

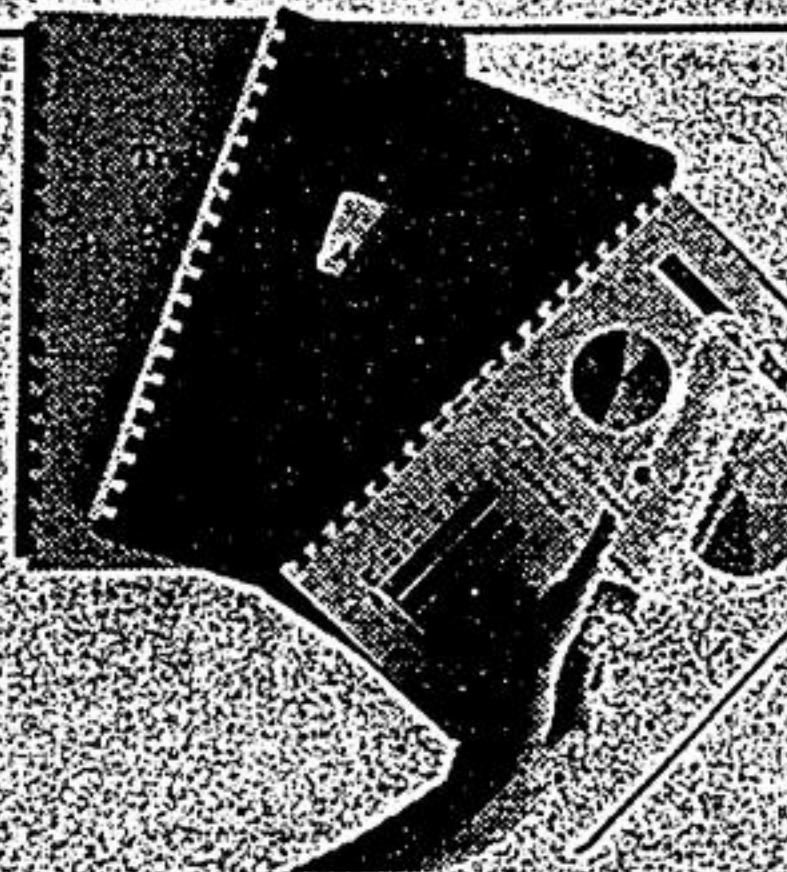
