Related to the subject of technology is *On Robot Wings: A Flight Thru the Solar System*, and others about space include *One Giant Leap for Mankind*, *The Apollo Legacy*, and *The Dream is*

*Alive: A Window Seat on the Space Shuttle*. These are all short pieces ranging from 22 to 45 minutes, perfect for adults with limited time and children with unlimited curiosity.

Speaking of which, it's sometimes surprising to see the choice of young children who have found their way into the documentary sheets.

*Hummingbirds Up Close* catch their eye with the great picture of the ruby-throated hummingbird on the cover. As well, many National Geographic videos appeal to all ages. With the weather we've had this past year, who isn't a little curious about *Nature's Fury!* with its tornado on the cover. The *Titanic* video is definitely hot, but there's also the *Search for Battleship Bismarck*.

So if you're looking for something for your curiosity, check out the documentary videos at the library. You know what they say about curiosity - satisfaction brought him back.
