

## Aggressive drivers target of OPP campaign

The message "Drive Friendly" is the focus of this year's aggressive driving campaign conducted by police services across Ontario between May 15 and 29.

Throughout the province in 1997, a total of 70,423 collisions were investigated by the OPP. In these collisions, 614 people died and more than 24,000 were injured. Aggressive

driving was the major factor. Most drivers have no problem identifying aggressive drivers, but many fail to recognize their own bad driving habits, said the OPP.

STS students are enthusiastic young ambassadors of their home country, between the ages of 14 and 18, with a strong desire to learn about Canada. STS staff carefully screen all students in their home countries to determine whether they have the maturity, academic achievements, language skills and adaptability to make the most of their experience in Canada.

STS students are covered by a complete health and accident insurance and provide their own spending money.
