in Goodwood, and says Corrig- an, "this band was the only extracurricular activity in the area involving that number of kids. Although invited to perform this year at the national finals being held in Vancouver, they declined. Corrigan felt that the financial strains of such a trip for the now 60-member band was just not feasible at this time. However, last summer, a chance meeting and subsequent conversation between Corrigan and Com- poser Don Coakley, Director of York University's wind ensemble,

led the band down another excit- ing, and challenging, musical road. During the course of this con- versation, Corrigan mentioned that he'd always wanted to "have a piece commissioned." Coakley's response to this was, "Then do it!" With the Goodwood School Community Council donating the funds for this exciting new ven- ture, work began in September, 1997 and was completed in Febru- ary, 1998 on the selected piece "Fantasy on Donkey Riding" with Coakley as composer. The pre- miere performance of this piece

will be presented in late May or early June at Goodwood Public School's Spring Concert. In addition to these undertak- ings, Corrigan has, since February, volunteered to help music teacher Wayne Hill, of Stouffville, work with a music group at St. Paul's Anglican Church in Uxbridge. Corrigan admits that juggling the many demands of home, school, and music is sometimes "unreal." He describes his wife Karen's unwavering support and understanding as "exceptional." He says, "Karen has incredible respect for who I am."


