### NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNERS TO DESTROY WEEDS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to all persons in possession of land in accordance with the Weed Control Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter W.5, Section 3, 16 and 23 that unless the noxious weeds or weed seeds growing on their lands within the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville are destroyed by June 15th, 1998 and throughout the season as often as it is necessary to prevent the ripening of their seeds and dispersal of their pollens, the Council of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville has appointed a Weed Inspector to cause said weeds or weed seeds to be destroyed in such manner as he may deem proper and that the expenses incurred by the said Weed Inspector in the discharge of his duties shall be placed on the Collector's Roll of the Municipality against the respective lands concerned and that such amounts shall be collected in the same manner as taxes.

Although Dandelions, Burdock and Goldenrod are not considered noxious weeds within the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville under the Weed Control Act, the co-operation of all citizens is solicited in the elimination of these nuisance weeds.

The co-operation of all persons concerned is earnestly solicited.

**THIS WEEK'S HEALTHY RECIPE**

**Roast Potatoes Bonne Femme (With Rosemary)**  
2 pounds tiny new potatoes  
2 tablespoons butter  
1 tablespoon olive oil  
2 teaspoons fresh oregano leaves, minced  
1/2 teaspoon fresh rosemary leaves, minced  
Seasoned salt or salt-free seasoning to taste  
Fresh ground pepper to taste  
Wash the potatoes thoroughly and place them in a vegetable steamer over boiling water 20-25 minutes or until they are tender when pierced with the tip of a sharp knife. Cool slightly and cut the potatoes in half or, using a paring knife, cut a strip of the peel from around each potato, leaving an attractive round cap on both top and bottom. Toss the potatoes gently with the 2 tablespoons of the butter, cut in 1/3-inch cubes, the olive oil, half the minced oregano, half the minced rosemary, the seasoned salt, and the pepper. Place in a preheated 425° oven for 15 minutes. Remove from oven and toss with the remaining butter and fresh herbs.
