## Barbecue helps charity

The date's been set for the 10th anniversary of Canada's largest barbecue party - Charity Barbecue Day - in support of the

of two major IBD research centres in Canada: one at McMaster University in Hamilton, Ontario and one at the University of Calgary.

Crohn's and Colitis Foundation of Canada (CCFC). On Saturday, June 13, barbecues at all M & M Meat Shops across Canada will light up in an effort to raise \$550,000 for medical research into inflammatory bowel disease (IBD). If this target is met, over \$3 million will have been raised in the event's ten year history.

In 1995, the University of Calgary became the home of CCFC Chair in Intestinal Disease Research, the first research Chair in Canada dedicated to learning more about IBD. It was also in 1995 that the CCFC honoured M & M Meat Shops, its largest donor, with the M & M Meat Shops Grant in Aid of Research, the first ever research grant named for a major benefactor.

Barbecues will be blazing from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. at each of the 230 M & M stores across the country. For a minimum of \$2, the public will receive either a hamburger or hot dog, a drink and a bag of Humpty Dumpty chips with all proceeds going directly to CCFC.

"As a result of our research, so much more is now known about the fundamental biology of the intestine, and it is more complicated and integrated than people would have anticipated ten years ago," explains Howorth. "Research is a slow process, but it's a vital and critical process to finding the cure, which I am confident will happen."

"Because of events like Charity Barbecue Day, we are able to invest hundreds of thousands of dollars annually into Canadian medical research," explains Michael Howorth, National Executive Director for the CCFC. "This year alone, the CCFC invested \$1.2 million into research, and the foundation has set an aggressive goal to be able to invest \$2 million annually for IBD research by the year 2000."

An estimated 250,000 Canadians suffer from IBD, of which Crohn's disease and ulcerative colitis are the principal forms. Anyone can develop the disease regardless of gender, age or race. IBD is non-contagious, and the cause and cure remain a mystery.

The Crohn's and Colitis Foundation of Canada is a voluntary, non-profit, medical research foundation dedicated to finding a cure for Crohn's disease and ulcerative colitis.

The CCFC also funds educational programs for health professionals, IBD patients and their families.

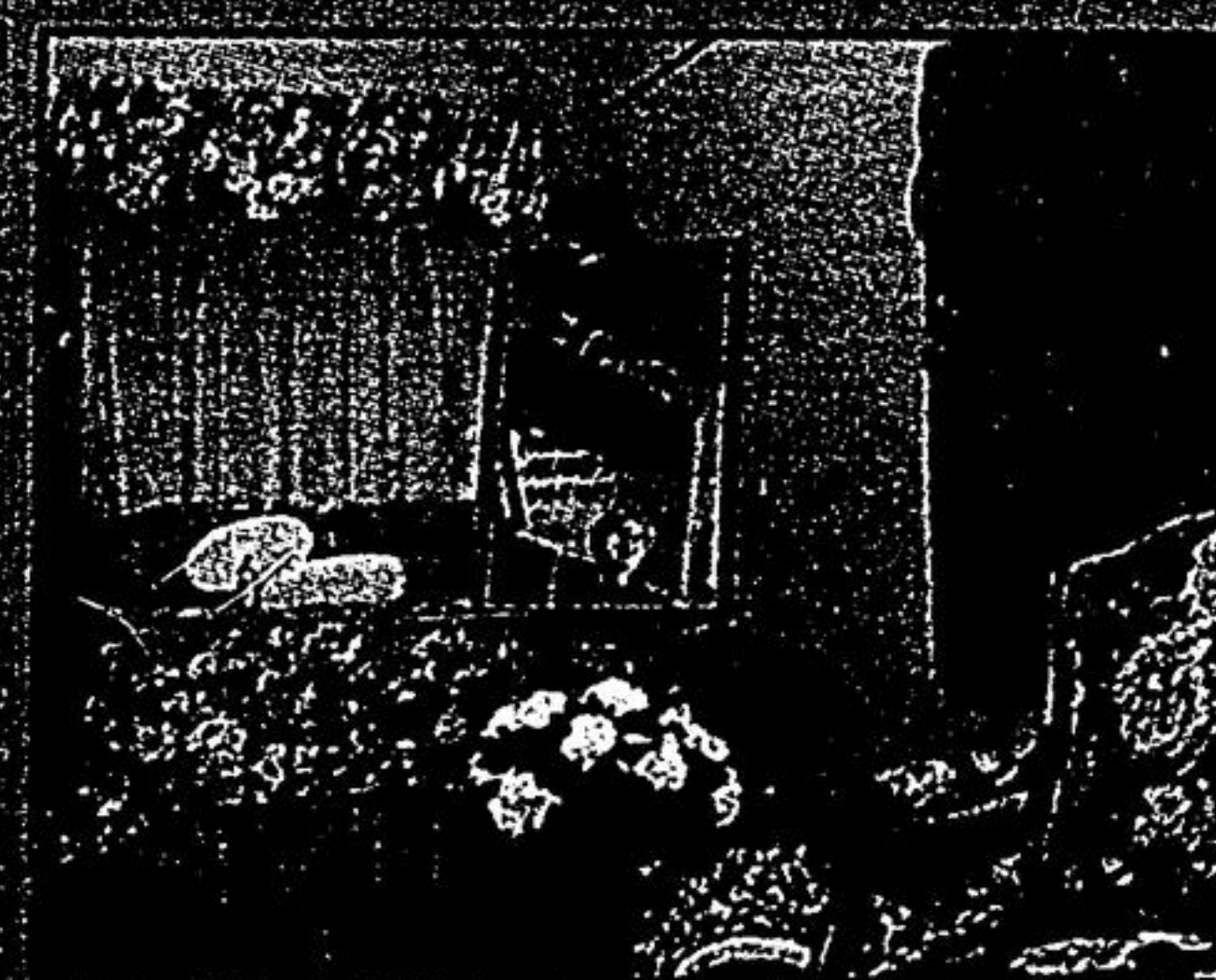
