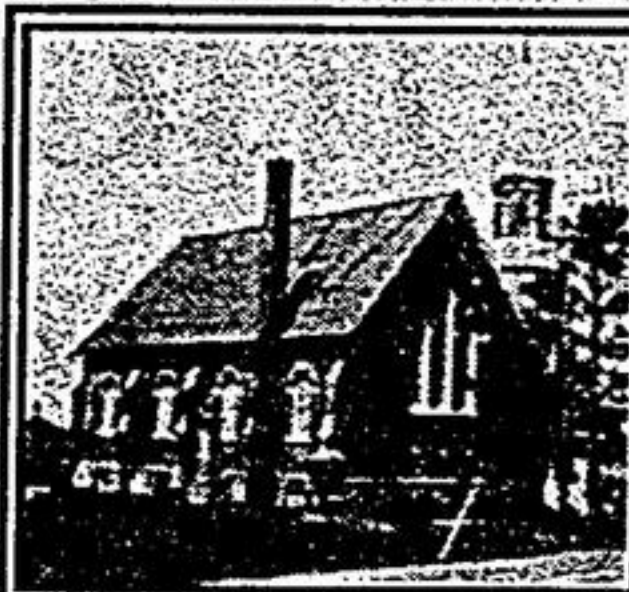
1998 FINAL TAX BILLS

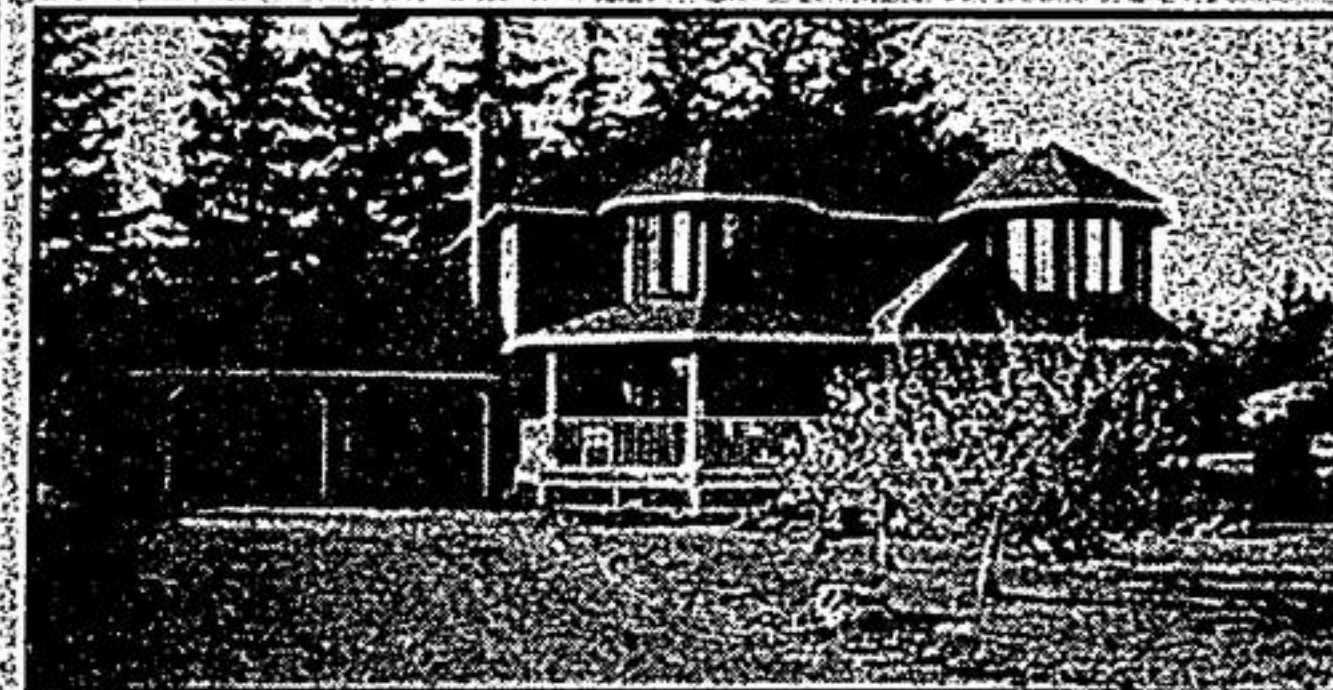

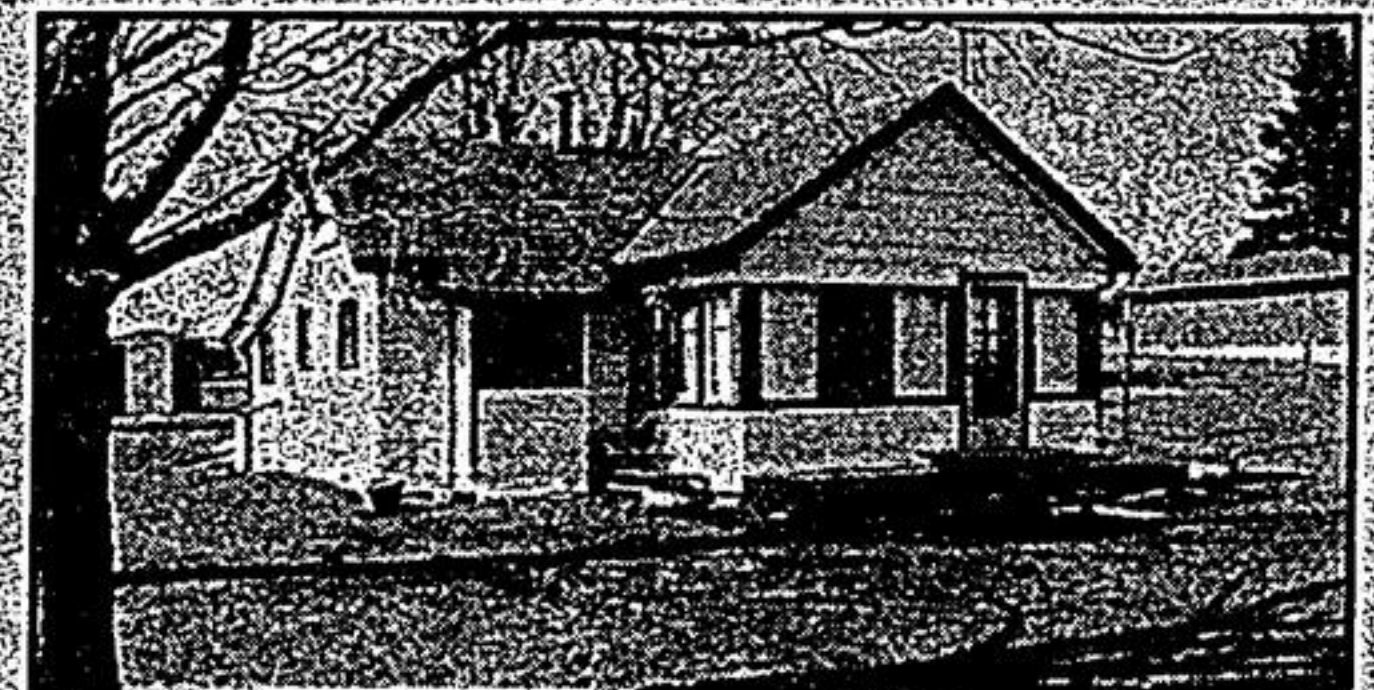

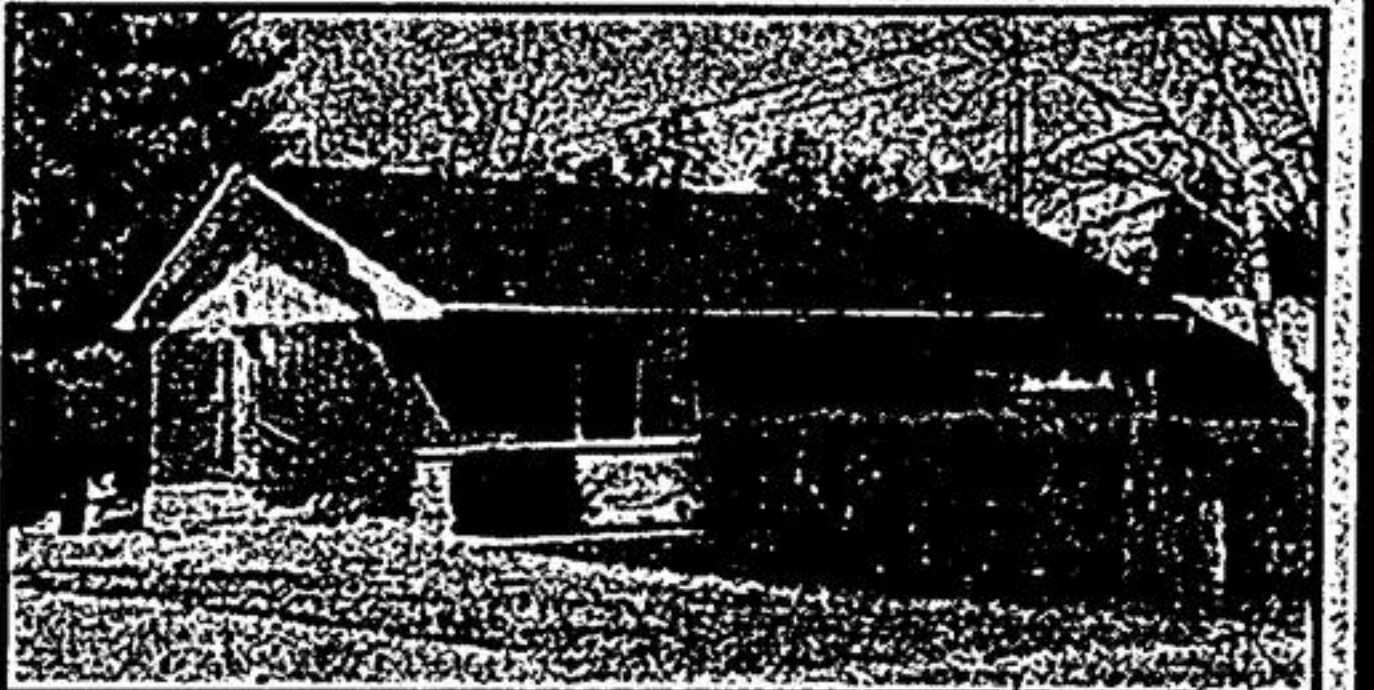
