Annual Crazy Kraft Race that combines both speed and boat originality. Saturday ends with a bang with a spectacular fireworks display.

Fisher said this year's display should be even better than the one held two years ago.

### Sunday Events

People who like an early start to their day can join the Fun Run - a 5K run - on Sunday. (There is also a

10K run for the more dedicated runners).

A social activity, many people walk or jog with their dog.

People can preregister (\$5 for people under 18 and \$10 for people over 19) or they can sign up the day of the event. (This costs \$8 and \$15).

The first 150 people will receive a free t-shirt and there will be medals handed out for the overall winner as well as the top three winners in each age category.

"It's a fun, local event. It's simply a way to get people moving."

The run starts at 8:30 am and the preregistration is from 7:30 am to 8 am.

The run usually last until about 10 am. A massage therapist will be available to runners after the event.

Where Saturday brings out people from all over, Sunday's Community Picnic is aimed at the residents of Unionville.

The picnic starts at noon when people converge to Crosby Park for the Pets 'N' Pals contest. Pets of all shapes and sizes are judged in a number of categories including owner/pet look-alike, best dressed pet, best trick, best talker and more.

Traditional pets like cats and dogs are often brought to the show, but Fisher said that all pets are welcome.

The day continues with children's races that include many traditional picnic games like the 40-yard dash, three-legged races and races children can do with their parents. Ribbons will be handed out to the winners in each race.

Adults, too, can join in the games with the egg toss.

At 3 pm, elementary school kids can participate in the battle of the schools by seeing which team (made up of 12 students) can win the Tug-of-War.

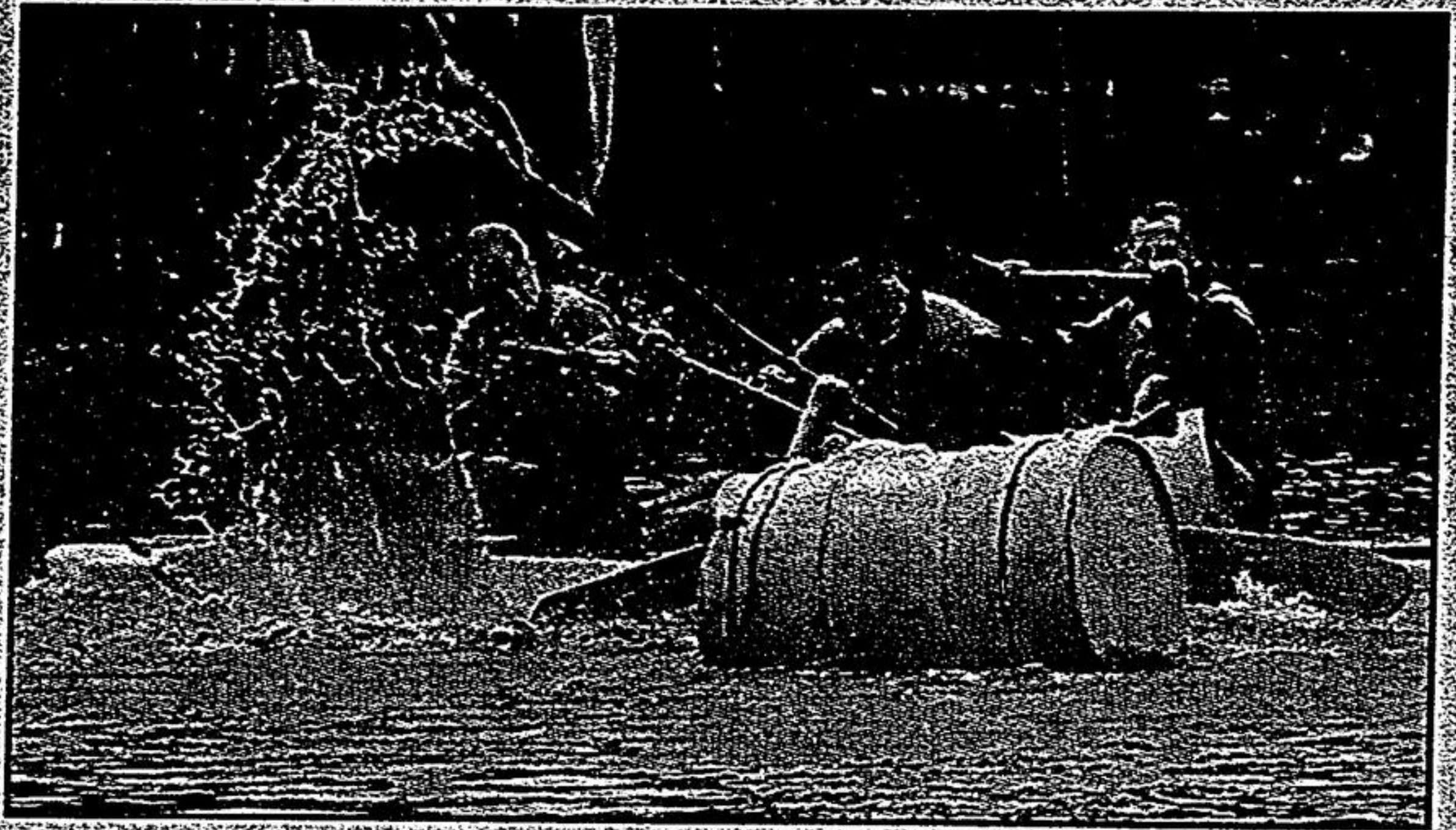
"It's the best community festival in the world," said Fisher. "It's a very social event."

It's hard to find a good parking spot during the festival, so Fisher suggested people park to the east and west of Main Street or at the Go Station. There is a shuttle bus provided to transport people to the festival and back.

People going to watch the fireworks must sit on the west side of Carlton Street. The east side of Toogood Pond is closed for safety reasons.
