

# Library releases mission statement

A revised mission statement has been released by the Whitchurch-Stouffville Public Library Board.

The board undertakes "To provide a multimedia collection, programmes and an information source which will allow citizens of the community equal opportunity to stimulate and satisfy their individual leisure, learning, cultural, intellectual and educational needs."

Board members have identified five goals aimed at improving service to community residents as follows: working together with the town as one in partnership; providing a library to meet all needs; defining the role of the

"The library board is moving positively ahead by providing many new programmes for all citizens of Whitchurch-Stouffville," noted a recent announcement by board members. "The board is focused on addressing the present and future needs of the community and is receptive to suggestions and ideas that will assist the board in this endeavour."
