Clean up or face lawsuit, farmer told

Farmer Vince Maiorano defended the state of his McCowan Road farm to Markham council Tuesday and says it was unfair of the town to deny him the zoning changes he requested.

Maiorano, who was accompanied by Ontario Federation of Agriculture representative Don Stevenson, told councillors he doesn't know what else to do.

"It's a farm, it looks like a farm," he said. "I don't know what still bothers you — what I do, I do."

But Mayor Don Cousens took a hard line with Maiorano, telling him unless changes are

made and made soon, the town will take him to court.

"The town does not wish you any ill will," he said. "All we are looking for is for you to abide by the bylaws. If you don't, all I can tell you is we'll see you in court."

"I don't want to go to court," Maiorano replied. "To say my family lives like pigs, I'd like to show you pictures."

But Cousens wasn't interested, saying Maiorano is being treated the same as any other resident.

On June 23, council denied Maiorano's request for a zoning change that would allow the continued use of a second dwelling on the property, despite a staff recommendation

that the town issue a one-year permit with the proviso he use that time to clean up the property.

Maiorano said in an interview he believed that recommendation was the final decision and that's why he did not attend council that night.

He insists he has complied with Markham bylaw officers over the years and has responded to requests for changes and clean-ups.

"We have done everything that's been asked of us. He (the inspector) is happy, so why are the councillors so upset?"

A staff report presented this week notes "a number of violations" have been identified.

Pepper spray used on man in fight

A Markham man was punched, kicked and sprayed with a pepper spray-type substance in the Goddess Nightclub parking lot last Sunday.

Sgt. John Sheldon said the two were almost to their car at 1:55 a.m. when four youths began running toward them. The man got his girlfriend into the car and was just opening his own door when he was sprayed in the face with an orange-yellow substance, and was punched and kicked.

He was driven him to Markham Stouffville Hospital where he was treated and released.
