

POLICE: Drugs, stolen vehicles seized

Biker gangs targeted in raid

Police have laid 74 charges against 17 people and recovered \$700,000 in stolen property after early morning simultaneous raids in Toronto and York and Durham regions Monday that targeted members of Satan's Choice motorcycle club.

York Regional Police Sgt. John Sheldon said police executed 14 search warrants, nine or 10 in York Region, including one at Digital Supercity on Pony Drive in Newmarket shortly before 7 a.m.

Most of the warrants were executed at residences in Vaughan, Aurora, Richmond Hill, Keswick and Wilfred east of Pefferlaw for fraud, drugs and stolen property charges.

A few of those charged were Satan's Choice members, he said, but the majority were biker associates.

Among those members of the club arrested and charged was Stephen Readhead, 36, president of the Keswick Satan's Choice chapter.

Officers recovered 12 vehicles, most of them sport utility trucks, a large boat, motor and trailer during the investigation, Sheldon said.

A large quantity (of the 4X4s) were purchased for a fraction of the cost by undercover officers.

Police also seized seven pounds of hashish, four pounds with a street value of \$16,000 was purchased as part of the investigation by undercover officers over the past few weeks, Sheldon said.

An additional three pounds, valued at \$28,000, was seized during the raids.

The raids, by a combined forces unit involving Toronto, York, Durham and provincial police that was set up to target outlaw motorcycle clubs, culminated a 16-month investigation, part of the ongoing Project Dismantle.

Funded by the Solicitor General's Ministry, the national project was established in 1995 to target outlaw biker gangs.

The tender loins of pork are sold fresh in the counter (pork chops, roasts, etc.) and those less tender are further processed into items which don't require such a tender cut. Our butchers are continuously amazed at my stubbornness on this point - and the delivery men from the pork companies are amazed at how often they visit us (4x a week) and how much pork chop they bring. So next time you're sitting down to a pork chop or roast and it turns out either tough or dry, or both, it probably didn't come from our store. To my knowledge, we are the only store I know of who go to these lengths to ensure eating quality. (More on this topic later).
