Man escapes gun-point carjacking

A 37-year-old shop owner, threatened at gun point Wednesday escaped injury and managed to ward off what may have been a carjacking attempt.

Police said the victim was approached by two men in the parking lot of a Hood Road commercial plaza about 7:15 p.m. As he opened his car door, he was pushed from behind. When he turned around, he confronted two suspects, one brandishing a black handgun.

They demanded he get in his car and when he refused, the gunman threatened to shoot him.

The man managed to break away, running to the front of a store in the plaza where he called police.

The two suspects fled on foot, one running north and one running south.

The gunman is described as male, Asian, six-foot, two-inches tall, weighing about 150 pounds and wearing a white baseball cap and a white hooded fleece shirt. The second man is about six feet tall, weighing 150 pounds, with brown hair.

Young teen attacked by girls

A 13-year-old Stouffville girl was attacked and robbed by three teenage girls Thursday afternoon.

The incident happened about 1 p.m. near Summitview Public School after the victim, who did not know her attackers, was forced into an argument with the three, police said.

Name calling soon escalated into a fight, the victim being knocked to the ground while the three suspects stole her knapsack. She suffered swollen lips and a sore shoulder, police said.

The attackers are described as white females, the first about 17 years old, wearing jeans and a T-shirt, the second about 13 with brown hair, blue eyes and wearing blue overalls. There is no description of the third suspect.

CD machines missing

A Riviera Drive company is out \$140,000 worth of computer equip-

ment after a theft Thursday night.

Thieves smashed the glass front doors of Fabco Corporate Express in Markham about 11:30 p.m. and searched until they discovered two CD duplication machines worth \$70,000 each. Damage is pegged at \$1,400.

Burglars target cars

Thieves netted more than \$11,500 Wednesday after stealing items from cars parked in residents' Unionville driveways or garages.

Police said the first theft occurred about 7:30 p.m. from a home on

Country Estates Drive. Suspects entered the garage by unknown means and opened up the unlocked car parked inside.

A cell phone and several pieces of identification were stolen before the suspects fled on foot. Theft value is about \$500.

In the second theft, between 7:15 Wednesday and 8 a.m. Thursday, suspects entered a vehicle parked in a driveway on Fred Varley Drive.

They removed a number of items inside, including \$11,000 worth of photography equipment.
