DIRECTOR - SOUTH EAST AREA

Working with Senior Management the Director of the South East Area will have lead responsibilities in the CCAC's Mental Health and Child & Youth Programs; manage client services programs and supervise multi-disciplinary team(s). The Director is a member of the management team with responsibility for assigned administrative functions and participates in the development and implementation of new programs and represents the CCAC on community initiatives and committees.

Eligible candidates will have a Baccalaureate degree in a Health Care discipline including valid registration with appropriate Professional College.
