Whitchurch-Stouffville council is about to find out if a 80-unit seniors' apartment complex will be built downtown. Local builder Gino Testa is scheduled to address council tonight at 7 p.m. The project has been on the drawing board for more than three years. Testa said he's had difficulty getting financing for the rental complex.

A 17-foot sign will be erected at the new cemetery in Gormley, if council agrees. Tonight, Memorial Gardens is asking local government to allow a ground sign, measuring 63-square feet, to be put up at Highland Hills, on Woodbine Avenue. The cemetery is under construction.

Civic Avenue from Main Street to the IGA parking lot will be closed on Nov. 27 from 6 to 8 p.m. to accommodate the Festival of Lights. The closure will let people mingle in the square in front of the former municipal building.

## SDSS to get new portable

Stouffville District Secondary School is about to get a 768-square-foot portable classroom. Tonight council is being asked to okay the addition. The portable will be used by 22 special needs students. Now, SDSS has 39 classrooms and a student population of 880.

Santa Claus will be the main feature in a parade scheduled for Saturday, Dec. 5 beginning at 1 p.m. The Santa Claus parade, organized by the Stouffville Kinsmen Club, will run until 3 p.m. Tonight, Whitchurch-Stouffville council is expected to give the go-ahead for the temporary closure of Main Street from Palmwood Gate to 10th Line.
