Stouffville man axes liquor cabinet

AXED FOR LIQUOR

Police arrested a Stouffville man Sunday after a prowler broke into an Uxbridge home and used an ax to open a liquor cabinet.

A burglar broke into the 7th Concession residence about 10 p.m. by smashing a window in the front door. Once the locked cabinet was opened, several bottles inside were removed, police said.

A 32-year-old Stouffville man arrested at the scene was charged with breaking and entering, mischief to property and possession of stolen property.

GAS STATION ROBBED

York Regional Police asking Sunday morning customers at the Petro Canada gas station on Main Street and Hwy. 7, Markham for help in catching an armed man who robbed the attendant.

A man entered the station kiosk around 9:30 a.m. Sunday, demanded all cash in the register and pointed a black handgun at the male attendant, police said.

After he was handed the money, about \$240, the bandit was last reported seen running east on Hwy. 7. Police described him as white, in his early to mid-20s, five foot seven and 200 pounds, stocky and wearing a blue denim jacket, a grey hooded sweatshirt pulled over his head and black jeans.

CANADIAN TIRE THEFT

Thieves smashed a glass door of the Canadian Tire store on McCowan Road, Markham late Sunday, and grabbed electronic equipment out of a display cabinet near the door, police said.

The culprits caused \$1,000 of damage in the 11:45 p.m. burglary but the value of items stolen has not been reported, police said.

GANG HOAX

A report of gang initiation rites involving motor vehicles and guns is a hoax, a York Region intelligence bureau officer said.

Det. Sgt. Jack Moore, commanding officer of the intelligence bureau, said the hoax has been occurring in a number of regions. He said copies of the e-mail message have been sent to IBM and the Jewish community.

Recipients of the e-mail, which warns drivers — specifically those living north of Steeles Avenue — about

suspicious behaviour of oncoming cars, which can lead to shooting in the dark. Apparently the authority for the information is a police officer working in the DARE Program.

"We don't even have a DARE Program," Moore said. York officers

checked with Toronto Police and discovered they don't operate a DARE Program either.




