"Sure, I wouldn't want concerts on Saturday nights," Bob said. "But we've had no problem with them."

The local business community also sees the market as a plus.

"I think it's a drawing card," Stouffville Chamber of Commerce president Ruth Boynton said.

According to Boynton, most local businesses don't look upon the market as unwanted competition.

"I don't think it takes away from the business of the town. And it certainly brings in tax dollars."

Past BIA chairperson Dave Barthau, who operates a jewelry store on Main Street, said the traffic generated by the market represents a huge opportunity for local businesses.

"The more people who come through town, the better opportunity to stop them," he said.

Barthau pointed to the free Christmas dinner staged by the market for those without families as proof of a caring commitment to the town.

When all is said and done, Rouse suggested the market has tradition on its side.

"We are still the original flea market in Southern Ontario. And we still draw a huge cross section from all across Southern Ontario. We want to remain a day in the country."
