

# Lottery funds available for local charities

There's close to \$73,261 up for grabs for Stouffville charities. Tonight, council will receive a report outlining the details of the Ontario Lottery Corporation's advance funding program which designates money for municipalities.

Local groups applying for the money include the First and the Third Stouffville Scouts, Friends of the (Vandorf) Museum, Whitchurch-Stouffville Mobility Transit, Whitchurch-Stouffville Public Library, York-Durham Heritage Railway, York-Durham Aphasia Centre and Whitchurch-Stouffville Hockey Association.
