A group of loyal customers and friends are coming together to host a dance for Dave Taylor's daughter Tammy, the Markham woman left in a coma following a tragic horse-back riding accident.

Next month the Carlton Show Band will be donating its time as part of a fundraiser to benefit the 29-year-old and her family.

Five months ago, a freak accident left Tammy Reid-Taylor in a coma with damage to her brain stem. It also left her in a Vancouver hospital for five months.

But six weeks ago, the family was put on alert that Tammy could no longer be accommodated in

that facility.

Last week, after desperately trying to find a hospital bed in Ontario, local politicians and media stepped in and Tammy was flown home to be cared for temporarily at York County Hospital until a long-term bed can be found.

While the cost of Tammy's flight home was covered by an unknown charity, the family still faces numerous expenses as they continue to address the demands of her condition.

The dance will be held at Our Lady of Grace Hall in Aurora Jan. 16.

Tickets are \$20 and doors will open at 8 p.m. There will be a cash bar and luncheon provided.

In accordance with Town of Markham By-law 5-94, all dogs within the Town of Markham must be registered and identified with the Town, commencing January 1, 1999.

Dog Registration	\$20.00 each dog
Dog Owned by Senior Citizens	\$10.00 each dog
(Senior Citizens are persons 65 years of age or older)	
Guide Dogs (required to be licensed)	No fee
A 50% reduction in fee is offered upon proof of micro chip number.	

NOTE: Under Provincial law it is compulsory for all dogs and cats in York Region to be vaccinated against rabies.
