### Davies Harley-Davidson wins Best Motorcycle Shop

Several years ago in 1992, after opening the Harley Davidson dealership in Oakridges, owners Bob and Robyn Davies earned just \$8 in sales following an entire day of business.

Today, the 15,000 square foot Yonge Street facility just north of Hwy #7 is a piece of motorcycle heaven for enthusiasts, with up to 50 bikes on display in the spacious showroom decorated with massive black and white murals dripping in Harley history.

More and more customers are coming to shop for Harley Davidson clothing and memorabilia. "Many people just want to be associated with Harley-Davidson and wear the brand. To our customer it's not a business, Harley Davidson is a way of life." Together with his architect, Davies developed the buildings' exterior design on the half hectare. Inside, the store is the first in Canada to be created by Harley-Davidson's new interior design company.

A full service department is located at the back of the building while the showroom offers everything from leather jackets, shirts and jeans to key rings and a multitude of gift items. There are over 21 different bike models to choose from ranging in price from \$8,300 to \$29,500. This is definitely a must see. Be sure to drop by and check it out.
