Trainer Rita Harte will also be at the seminar to teach job searchers how to communicate for a successful interview.

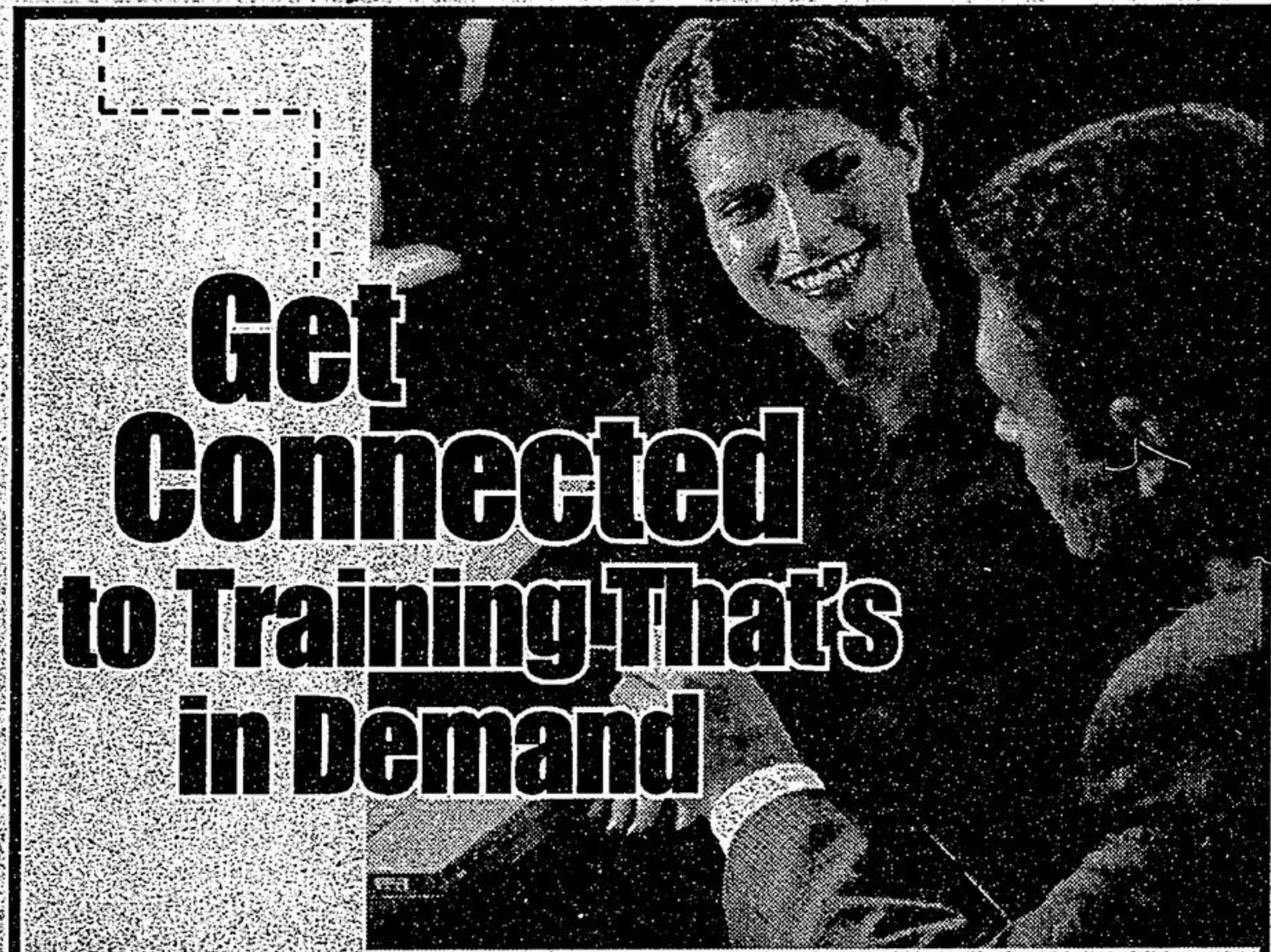
The presentation — starting at 10 a.m. — will take approximately two hours and there will be time for questions and answers in between each topic.
