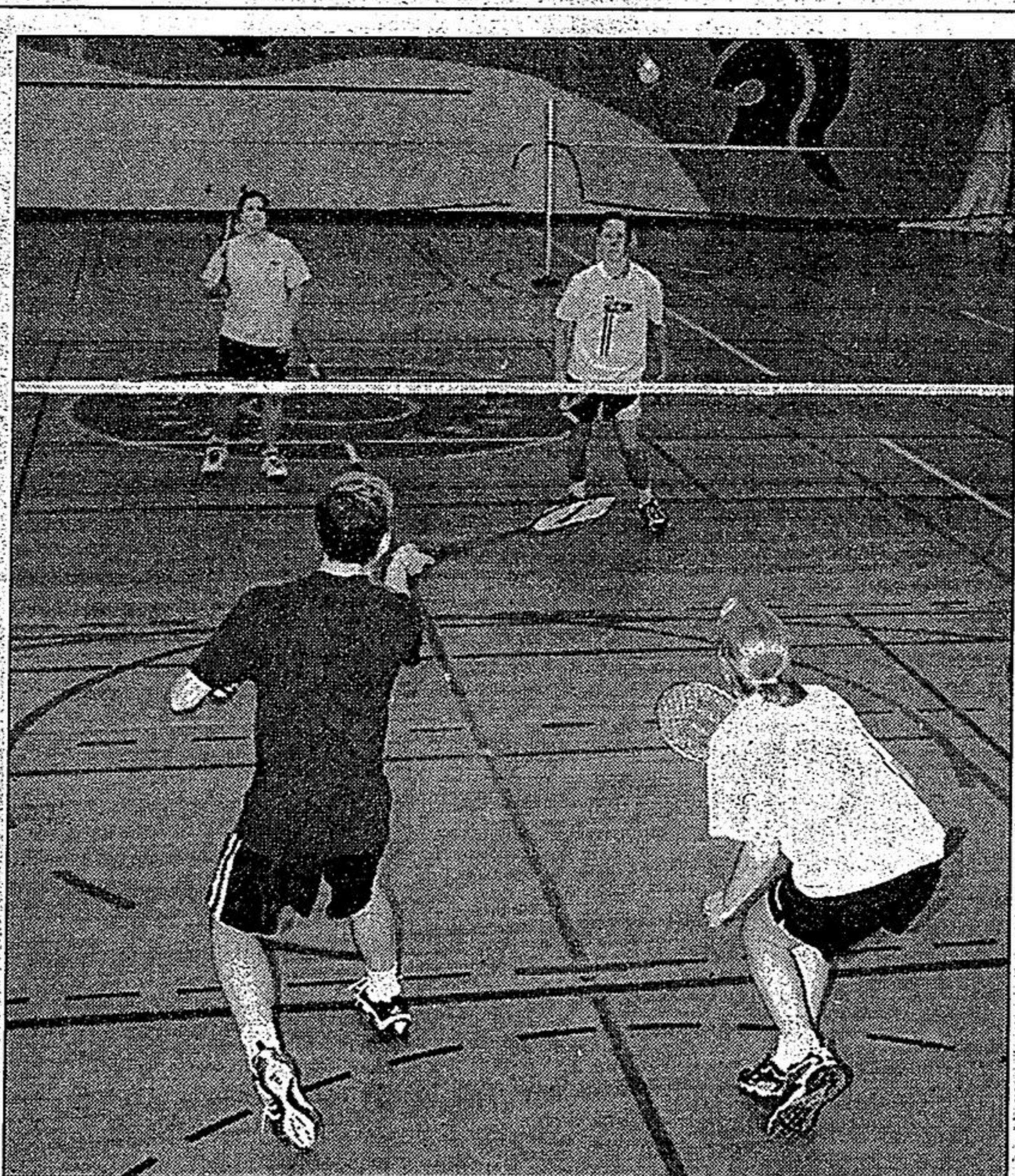

goal.

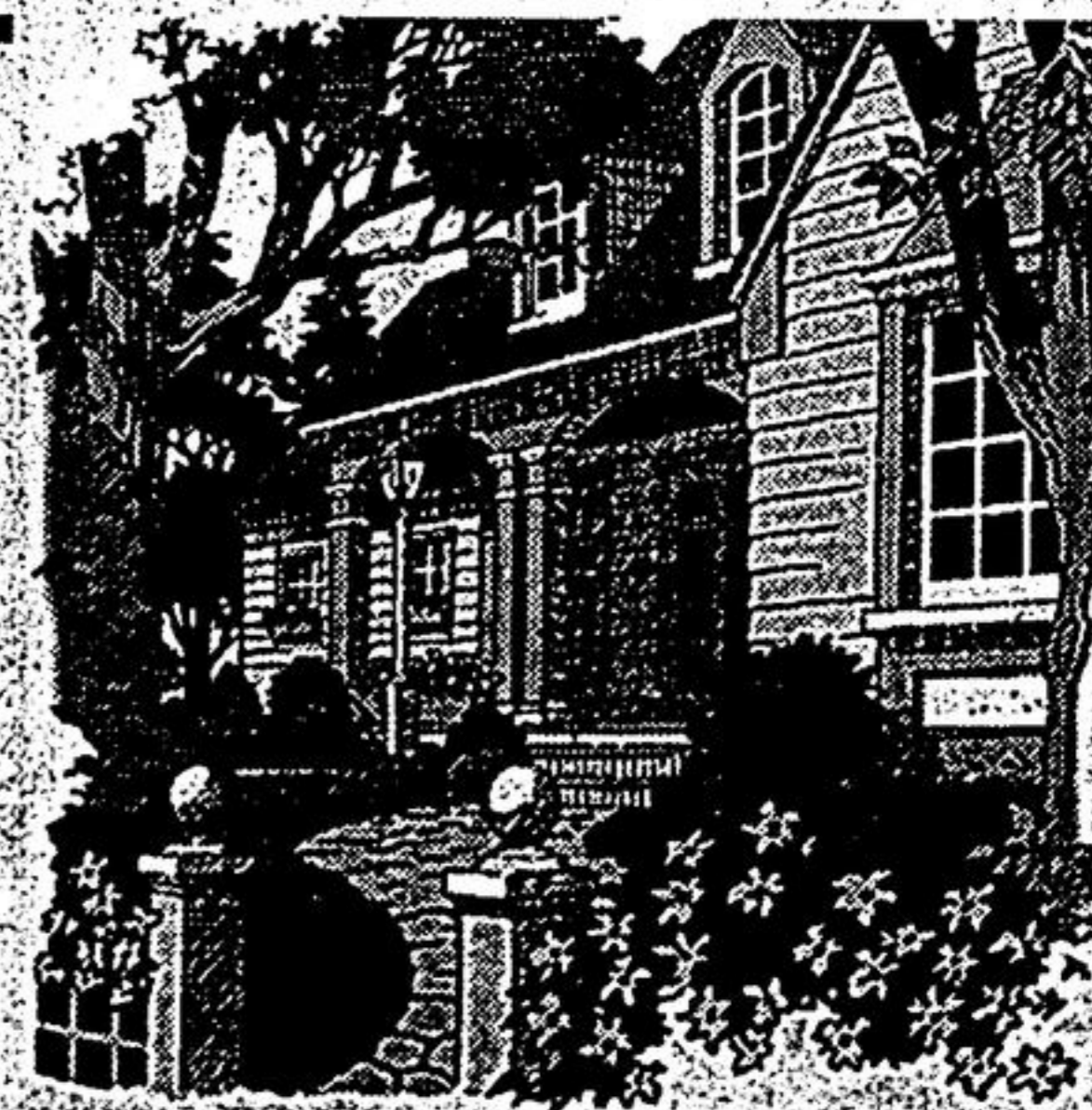
