Police officer helped Swiss Air rescue workers

When SwissAir flight 111 went down over Peggy's Cove last September, area families rushed out in their fishing boats to hunt for survivors.

But the horror that greeted them was beyond imagination.

"Residents saw and heard the crash. All they could envision was people who had survived and were waiting to be rescued, like passengers aboard the Titanic. They took blankets and coffee for any survivors," said York Regional Police Const. Duncan Foot. "But when they got out there, there was no one to rescue. It was just body parts."

Eight weeks after the crash, Foot went to Nova Scotia at the request of Health Canada to help counsel the traumatized rescue workers — including police officers, coast guard officials, transportation safety personnel, army civilians and fishermen, many of whom are members of the coast guard auxiliary.

They all had horrible stories to tell, of working up to 16 hours a day retrieving human remains, or trying to identify body parts in the morgue. Of the 229 passengers and flight crew who died, officials only found the partial remains of 11. Often, the body parts they found were horrifying.

Foot, a 13-year veteran officer, is a founding member of the York Region critical incident stress management team, which counsels emergency personnel after traumatic events. He was presented with an award by Health Canada for his work recently. Health Canada was so impressed with Foot's counselling abilities, the agency flew him back to Nova Scotia for a second tour.


