Suspect sought in sexual assault

York Regional Police are hoping a composite picture of a sex assault suspect will generate enough information to make an arrest.

An exotic dancer at Bunnies accepted a ride home from a customer after her shift early on the morning of May 14.

After leaving the Anderson Avenue club about 2:30 a.m., the suspect drove south on Hwy. 48 before pulling into a Town of Markham maintenance yard on Princess Street.

The 26-year-old was sexually assaulted in the front seat of the car.

The suspect then pushed

her out of the vehicle and sped away.

Police said the woman fought the suspect.

"The suspect should have scratches on his face and throat," said Const. Terry Jordan. "She has acrylic nails and probably did some damage."

The victim feels the composite is about 90 per cent accurate — but while the face looks young, the suspect is believed to be in his mid-30s.

The suspect is six feet tall, weighing 200 pounds and has a double chin which is not clear in the picture.

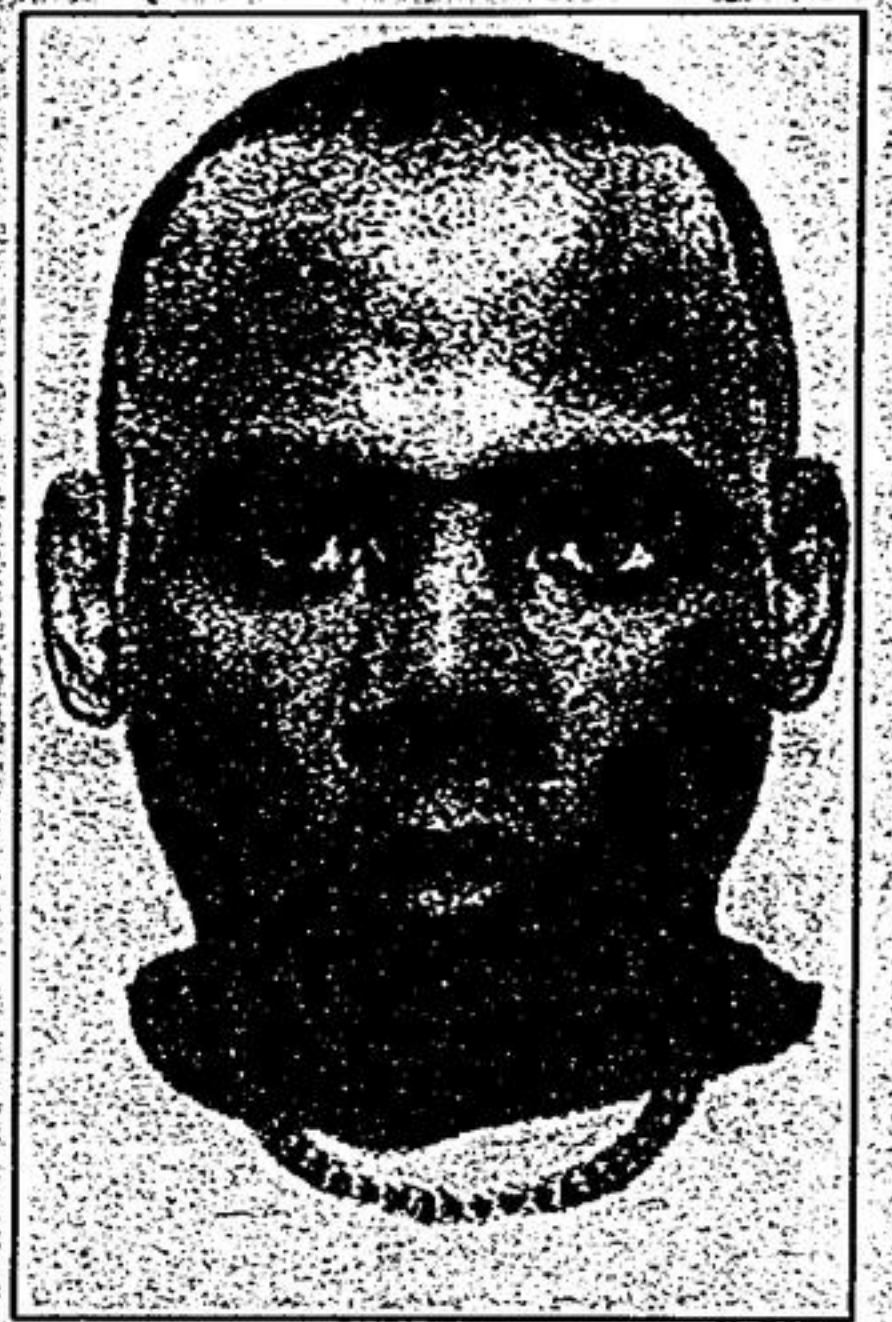
"The hair, the eyes, the cheekbones are pretty close," Jordan said.

The suspect could have a job where he works with his hands, which are described as grease-laden, especially the knuckles and fingernails.

He's likely a local resident as he seemed to know his way around, Jordan added.

"And he claimed to have been married, so his wife may have questions about the scratches."

The car he was driving was a black, new model Chevrolet Cavalier with a plate number similar to or containing the digits LCN 364. Anyone who recognizes this man or who has any information is asked to contact Jordan at 881-1221, ext. 7541 or Crime Stoppers at 222-TIPS.

Kennedy Road closure slated for summer

A section of Kennedy Road in Markham will be closed in July for as many as 12 days, York Region's transportation department says.

The need to build deep, storm and sanitary sewers for a nearby housing development makes a temporary closure of the road necessary from 16th

Avenue to Major Mackenzie Drive, the region recently determined.

The closure will follow 15 days of lane restrictions, which are expected to begin around June 14.

Only local traffic will be allowed in while Kennedy is closed.

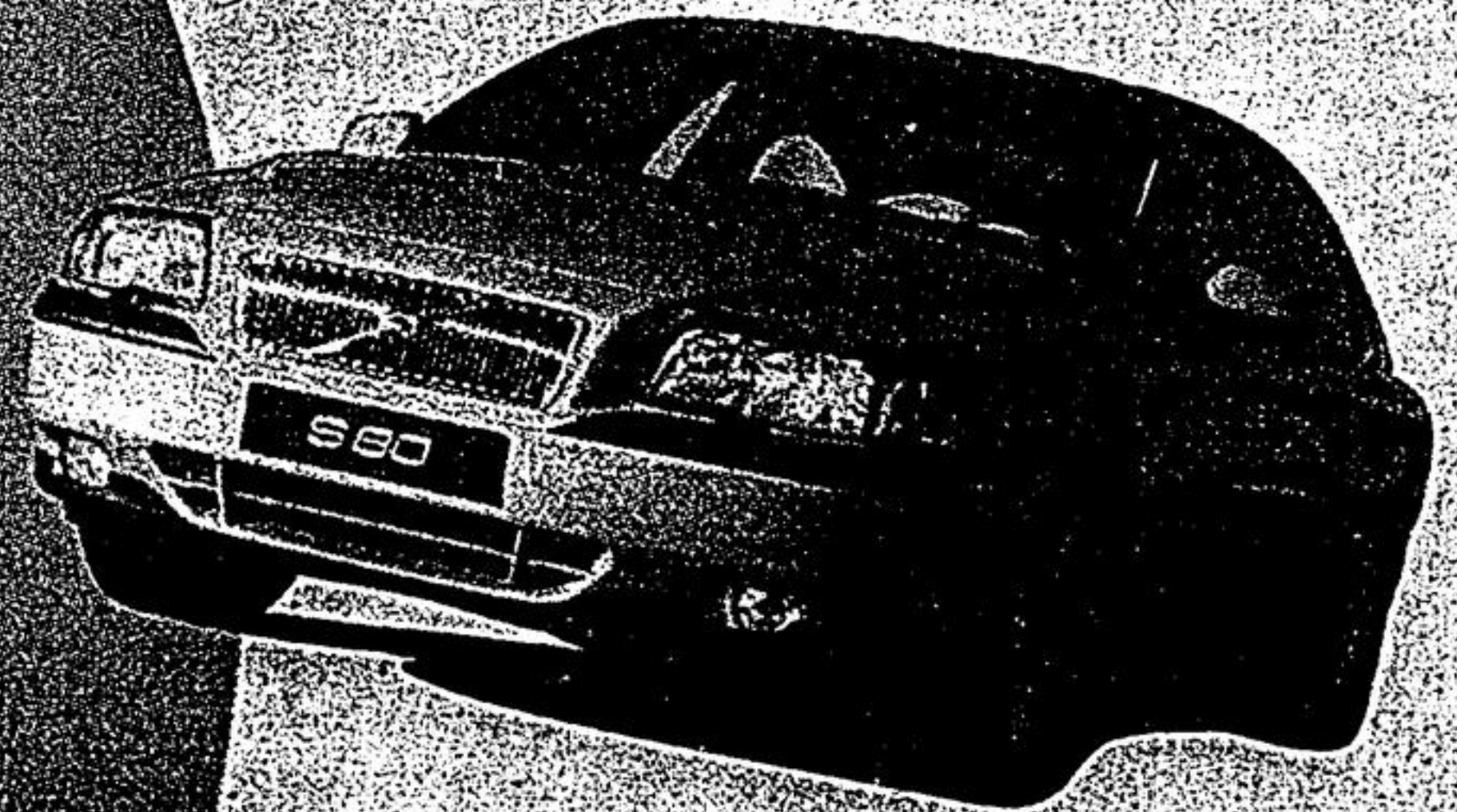
Kennedy is a busy arterial, used by an

The region's transportation department said posted signs would give two weeks' warning of the closure.

"To minimize inconvenience to road users, it is proposed that the closure begin on a Monday," the department said in a report.
