Felepchuk sets school records at OFSAA meet

It was personal bests and school records for a trio of Stouffville District Secondary School athletes at last weekend's Ontario Federation of School Athletic Association Track and Field Championships at Etobicoke's Centennial Stadium.



Lisa Felepchuk smashed two SDSS marks at the gathering of the top high school track and field athletes in Ontario, which was hosted by the York Region Athletic Association.

She rewrote the school record book in both the midget girls' 1,500-metre and 800m events.

Her time of 4:58.22 in Friday's 1,500m final was good enough for a seventh-place finish in the province.

It also gave her the best time ever for an SDSS midget, junior or senior girls' runner.

Felepchuk, who won the 800m midget girls' championship at this spring's YRAA Central Region finals, posted a personal best time of 2:25.9 in her heat Saturday.

While leaving just short of a trip to the finals, her time represented another SDSS midget girls' record, eclipsing by almost five seconds the mark set by Andrea Crothers in 1990.

The Stouffville school's Kevin McGrath followed up his midget boys' shot put gold at the Central Region

finals with a ninth-place overall finish Friday.

His throw of 13.55m was a personal best, but left him just .17m short of a trip to the finals.

Megan Sealy rounded out the SDSS trio, competing in the midget girls' javelin.

SDSS coach Fred Robbins said Felepchuk's performance was a hint of what lies ahead.

"This is probably the beginning of several trips to OFSAA for her," Robbins said as he predicts a bright future for several of the school's midget girls runners. "Our midget girls are really fast."

Robbins was one of three SDSS coach/officials who were involved in running the OFSAA meet.
