Road Watch program costs town \$10,000

Stouffville will go under surveillance Aug. 16.

At a cost of \$10,000, the local Road Watch Program is about ready to start, Councillor Cliff Dunkeld said.

Ballantrae resident Herb Bell, a member of the Road Watch program committee, is expected to give council an update on the program at its regular meeting tonight.

Criminals and speeders are being watched from all angles, Dunkeld said.

Road Watch is designed to curb speeding, allowing citizens to fill out a report through the town if they witness incidents which threaten the safety of local roadways.

If a Whitchurch-Stouffville resident spots a speeder, the vehicle license plate number can be recorded on the form, Dunkeld said.

Forms can be dropped off at the municipal office, the library and at drop-off spots in Vandorf, Gormley and Ballantrae.

The form would then be handed over to the police, and the offender would be notified.

The municipality will mail forms to all residents in the near future.

Group asks for tender delay

A request to postpone the tender for Stouffville's indoor pool and library project is being made.

Tonight, a citizens group is expected to ask council to delay any decision on the South Park recreation development

until the proposed Official Plan amendment is made.

Access road to cost \$216,000

A \$216,000 contract to build an access road to Stouffville's new pool and library facility at O'Brien and Rose avenues is expected to be awarded to Miwel Construction Ltd. at tonight's council meeting.

The cost of the new road will come from development charges.

Boyd's Sports to move

Boyd's Sports will relocate to Ringwood Avenue if council gives the nod tonight.

The Main Street business has applied to the town for a site plan application for a 5,220-square-foot warehouse to be built on a one-acre site on Ringwood Drive.

Is town ready for Y2K bug?

The Y2K bug will be front and centre at the Whitchurch-Stouffville council meeting tonight.

Resident Jim Priebe is expected to outline his concerns about the so-called 2000 problem known as the millennium bug.

Priebe wants a run-down on what steps are being taken by the municipality to ensure residents' continuation of services when the clock strikes 12 on December 31, ringing in the new century.

Anastasis Strezos, 32, of Markham, has been charged with public mischief and dangerous driving, and his passenger Kirikos Soubasis, 32, with public mischief.

Wolfe said the real story emerged when police realized Strezos' and Soubasis' account didn't add up.

"They didn't exactly give the right evidence," he said. "The suspects were quite honest (about their actions). While Strezos and Soubasis weren't entirely truthful, Wolfe said Strezos didn't deserve to be attacked.

"Nobody deserves to be beaten or assaulted for anything."

Wolfe called the incident a truer reflection of road rage than originally thought because the actions of people on both sides escalated until the altercation resulted in violence.

"This could be a test case for road rage."


