CRIME

Armed robbers hold up massage parlour

A trio of bandits carrying handguns robbed four employees at a Markham massage parlour yesterday.

York Regional Police said three of the four female victims at Relax 2000 tried to hide in a broom closet during the 3 a.m. robbery but were discovered by the intruders, who took cash from all four employees.

The employees at the Alden Road business were not injured, police said. The bandits, who were dressed in dark hooded sweatshirts, escaped in a dark four-door Honda or Toyota, police said.

The first suspect is described as male, black, five feet six inches tall and weighing 140 pounds, wearing a black hat; the second is male, black, six feet tall and weighing 150 pounds, wearing baggy pants and sunglasses; the third suspect is male, black, six feet tall and weighing 150 pounds, wearing sunglasses and a red bandana.

Dump truck stolen

A thief drove a dump truck worth an estimated \$75,000 out of a company compound on Cardico Drive in Stouffville Monday night.

Police said \$500 in damage was caused in the evening robbery, during which the lock securing the compound was cut off.

House entered through window

A home on St. John's Sideroad in Stouffville was broken into on Monday and more than \$5,000 in jewelry, electronics and china stolen.

Police said the house was entered through an open window and \$50 in damage was caused.

Man impersonated a president

Police are searching for a man who, identifying himself as the president of a business, twice made deposits with fraudulent cheques made out to that company at a Markham CIBC branch on Woodbine Avenue.

The deposits were from accounts either closed or with insufficient funds and the suspect also withdrew large sums of U.S. currency, police said.

The man's actions were reported this week, after the company's real president arrived at the bank, police said.

Cat burglar suspect faces 97 charges

A Woodbridge man has a date with a judge after police laid charges in a string of cat burglaries that plagued Woodbridge and Thornhill over a three month period.

Sgt. John Sheldon said a man was originally arrested June 20 for possession of a stolen car after a foot pursuit in a crowded restaurant.

Subsequent investigation tied him to numerous break-ins and resulted last week in a total of 97 property-related charges.
