Road to new pool/library complex crosses site of old town dump

The access road leading into Stouffville's planned \$5.5-million indoor pool/library complex will sit on top of an old dump.

In the 1920s, there was a municipal dump in the Rose Avenue area south of Franklin Street. The dump was shut down in 1948.

The old dump does not pose an environmental threat, Mayor Wayne Emmerson said.

"We've done the drilling on the site. There is not a problem," he said. "If we run into any garbage, we'll move it to a landfill site."

Work on the complex's access road is expected to get under way very soon, while construction of the 32,000-square-foot twin facility is scheduled to begin in the spring. It is hoped the complex will be open before the end of next year.

Some residents have objected to the chosen site, to the fact the existing library will be moved

and to the overall operating costs, while others have suggested there's been a lack of public input on planning.

Planning official makes move

Another of Whitchurch-Stouffville's top town officials has resigned, Mayor Wayne Emmerson has confirmed.

John Linhardt, the town's planning manager, has notified council that he will be leaving to take a similar position in the planning department in Halton.

The town will advertise to fill the vacant post, Emmerson said. Planning staff will fulfill the duties until a new manager is hired, he said, with department director Tom Parry and planner Bill Moyer overseeing operations.

A few months ago, director of community and leisure services John Crawley resigned, while earlier this year, town treasurer Ed Blackburn retired.
