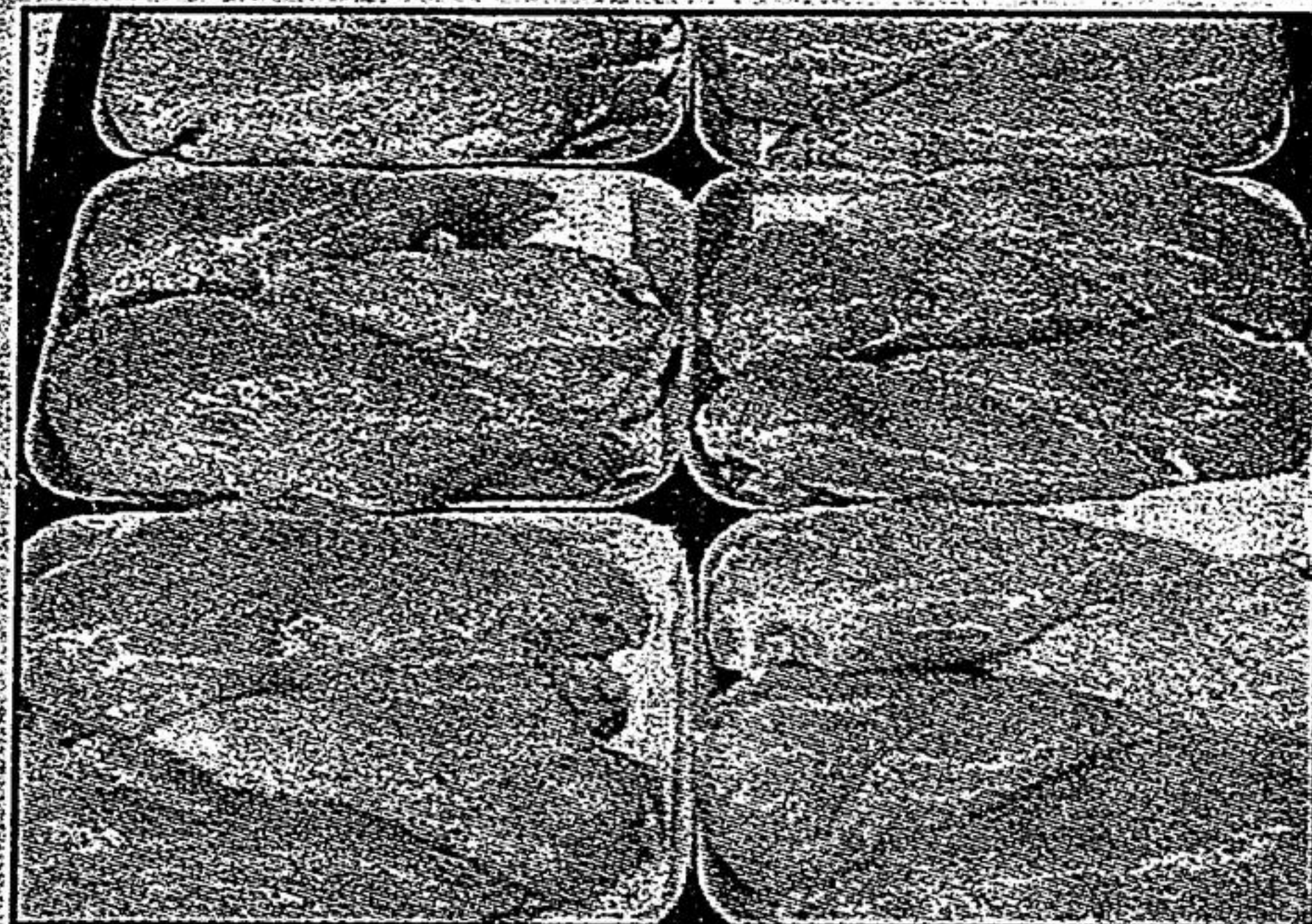

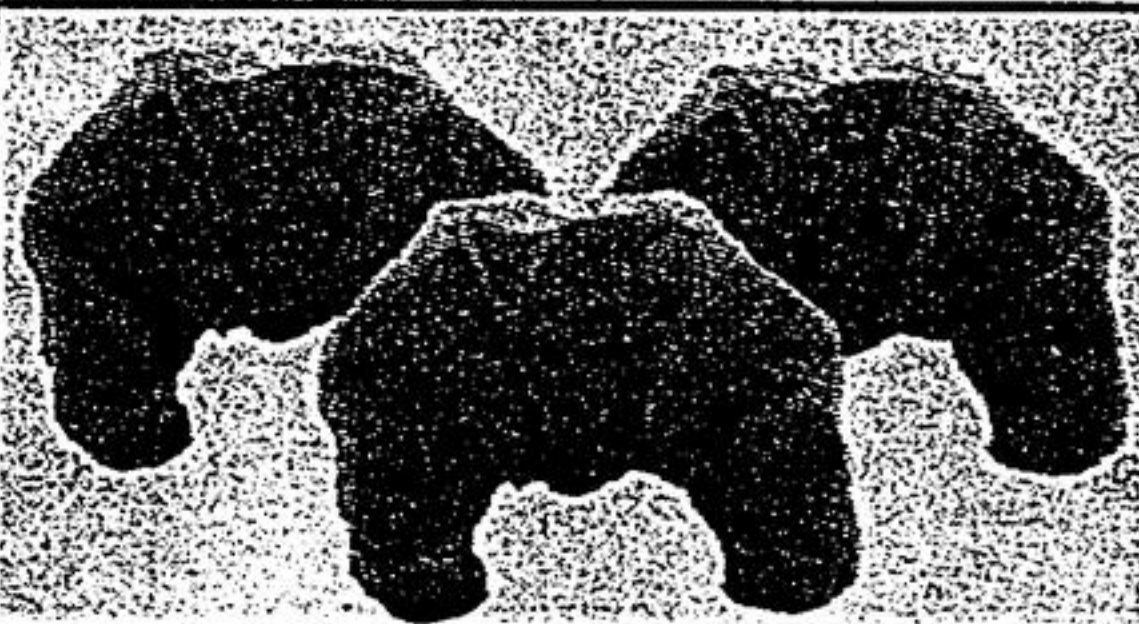

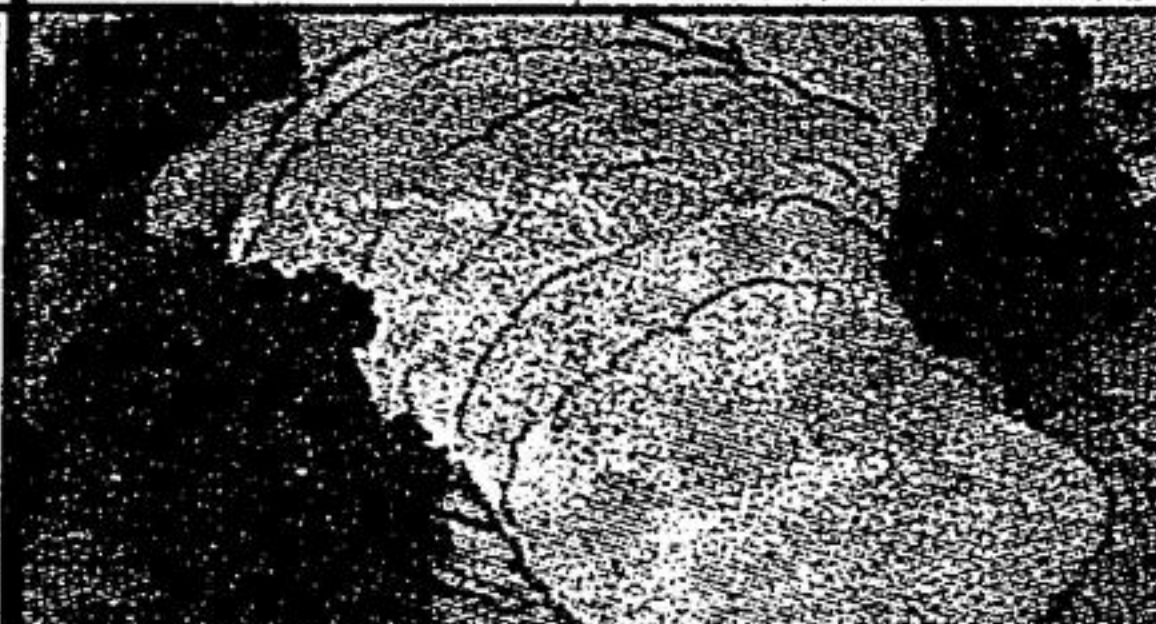

Blood donors needed

Tomorrow's blood donor clinic in Stouffville is critical. Since supplies of O and A blood types have dropped to critically low levels at the Toronto Blood Centre, local donors and potential donors are being urged to attend area clinics, including one at the Legion Hall on Ninth Line between 3 and 8 p.m. Canadian Blood Services is calling on all regular blood donors to come out and give.

"We are also encouraging those who have never given blood before," director of donor services Michele Leroux said. "This summer has seen the gradual decline in blood donations which occur every year," Leroux said. "But the need for blood never takes a holiday."

Cancer patients and those undergoing life-saving surgeries need blood year-round, Leroux pointed out.

Residents are reminded that healthy people aged 17 to 70 can give blood every 56 days, although first-time donors must be under the age of 61. Donors are required to have their donor card or photo and signature ID.

United Way seeks \$4.5 M

The cost of growth this year is \$500,000. That's how much the goal of the United Way of York Region — \$4.5 million — exceeds the target for last year's annual fundraising campaign.

The new goal is ambitious, but it is necessary to keep up with the region's phenomenal growth, said Wyn Chivers, the United Way's executive director.

The charity umbrella is asking everyone to contribute 10 per cent more this year, and it is confident they will, Chivers said yesterday. "Our experience is the community can come through for us."

So far, less than \$1 million has been raised for the campaign, which is scheduled to end in late November or early December.

Last year, the York Region United Way, which has a slogan of Help Build a Better Community Together, managed to raise \$4.1 million to support 39 local agencies.

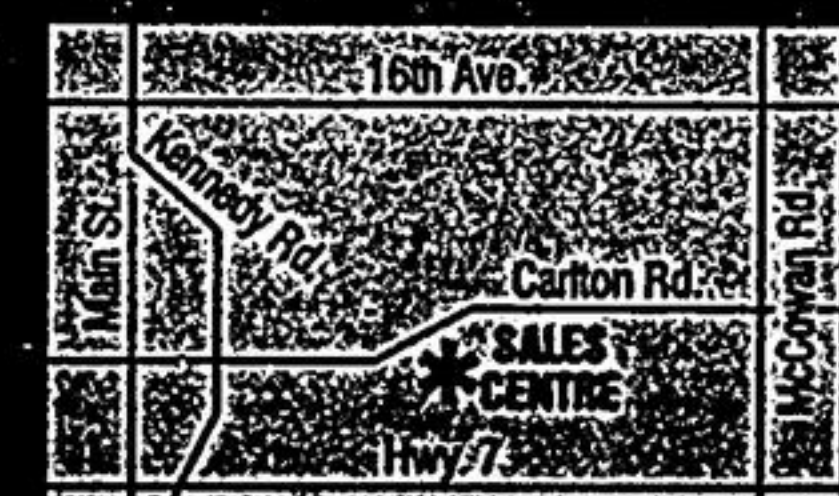
