# Scholarship honours memory of young artist

Jason Sincarsin is gone but his art lives on.

The 18-year-old King City student died suddenly Dec. 8 after his car hit a patch of black ice while he was on his way to school.

The end came quickly for Jason, who died instantly of massive head injuries in the King Road crash.

But the Unionville High School student's memory will survive through an art scholarship set up by his parents, Glen and Susanne, and his 14-year-old brother Bryan.

"We wanted something positive to come out of this," Susanne said, surrounded by her son's paintings in her King City living room. "He loved the school and his art so much, this is a way for him to live on there."

Jason was a graduate of the elite Arts

York program in the Markham secondary school and had been accepted at Sheridan College, where he planned to study animation.

The Jason Sincarsin Scholarship Fund will help provide post-secondary education for a graduate of Arts York.

"We couldn't help Jason go on to college, so we'd like to help someone who has the same sentiments as he did," Glen said. "Hopefully, we'll get enough funding to keep it going for some years."

Jason's father is still wondering what happened when his son's Ford Mustang spun out of control on King Road west of Bathurst Street.

"He wasn't a poor driver and the police say there was no excessive speed involved," Glen said. "Witnesses said everyone was driving at steady speed."

When emergency crews arrived on the scene about five minutes after the three-car collision, Jason's seatbelt was

on and the driver's side airbag was engaged.

Emergency crews told the Sincarsins Jason appeared as if he were asleep.

"When I saw the car, it looked like you should've come out of there OK," Glen said. "It's hard to explain."

Jason was killed on a day when black ice plagued the region's roads. Three people, including Jason, were killed and five others were seriously injured.

Jason's death touched fellow students at Unionville High School and co-workers at the Cineplex at Markville Mall.

A memorial has been set up at the movie theatre and co-workers signed a Cineplex T-shirt, which was given to the Sincarsins.

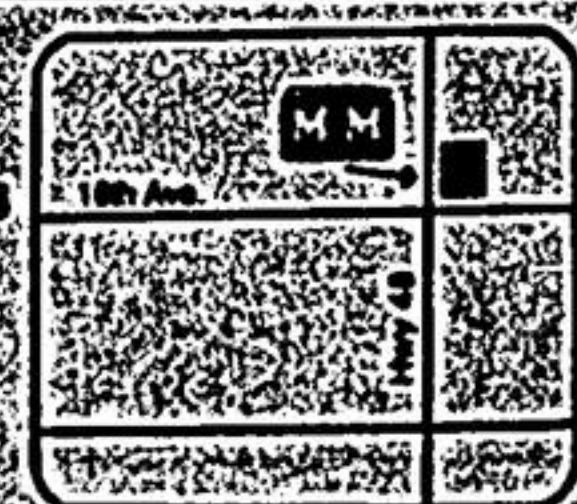

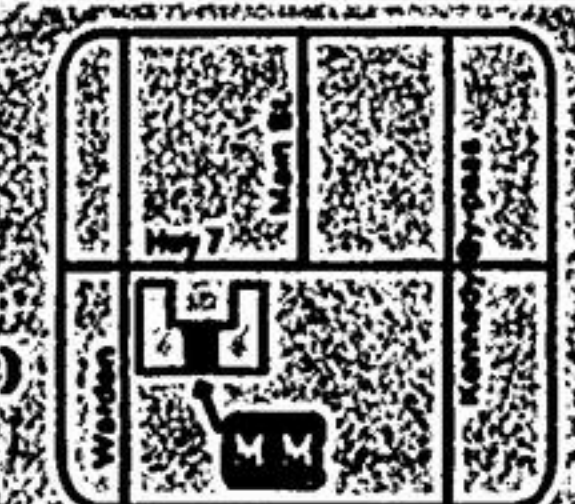
