**Class Environmental Assessment
Highway 404 Improvements
16th Avenue to Bloomington Road
W.P. 432-98-00 & W.O. 99-23015**

The Ministry of Transportation has completed the detailed design study for improvements to Highway 404 from 16th Avenue to Bloomington Road. The proposed improvements include:

Widening of Highway 404 From 4 to 6 Lanes From Major Mackenzie Drive to Bloomington Road

- Construction of an additional north and south bound lane within the median;
- Minor drainage improvements;
- Roadside safety improvements (e.g., guide rails upgrades, rumble strips), and
- Construction of a landscape berm with excess clean fill north of Vandorf Sideroad on the east side of Highway 404.

16th Avenue/ Highway 404 Improvements

- Construction of a ramp to access Highway 404 northbound lanes from 16th Avenue interchange; and
- Construction of a ramp to access 16th Avenue from Highway 404 southbound lanes

The purpose of this notice is to inform you that the Transportation Environmental Study Report has been completed and submitted for public review. The report documents the proposed improvements and the planning process used to select the recommended design. The proposed construction constitutes a Group B project under the Class Environmental Assessment for Provincial Transportation Facilities, 1999.

The Transportation Environmental Study Report has been filed with the Ministry of the Environment for the 30-day public review period in accordance with the Class Environmental Assessment for Provincial Transportation Facilities. At the end of the 30-day public review period the project will be free to proceed to construction. This notice starts the 30-day public review period.

There is an opportunity at any time during the review period for interested persons to provide comment. If after consulting with staff, you feel that serious environmental concerns remain unresolved, you have the right to request that the Minister of the Environment (135 St. Clair Ave. W. Toronto, Ontario M4V 1P5) "bump-up" the project thereby requiring an individual environmental assessment.
