Big brothers raise big money for kids

More than 1,700 bowlers raised \$245,000 in this year's edition of the Big Brothers Bowl For Kids Sake — \$43,000 more than last year.

"It's a significant increase over last year, but everyone went all out because this was the 25th anniversary of the event," said Maddy Nichol of Big Brothers.

There were 11 bowling events that took place from mid-February to early March in eight communities. There were also two corporate challenges involving banks and car dealers that raised more than \$75,000.


"The banks alone raised \$50,966," said Nichol. Markham led the way in the public bowling events, raising \$46,984, followed by Richmond Hill with \$40,856. Newmarket, with two bowling dates, was next with \$31,808 and Aurora bowlers raised \$21,270.

Georgina raised \$9,773, Vaughan \$6,658 and Bradford was next with \$6,471. The Stouffville bowlathon brought in \$3,919.

Though no one at Big Brothers has kept a running tally over the 25 years of the bowlathon, the amount raised for the organization has been significant.

In 1976, its first year, 75 bowlers raised \$13,000 in a single event in Newmarket.

They raised \$25,000 in 1988, \$35,000 in 1989, \$60,000 in 1990 and topped the \$100,000 mark for the first time in 1996.
